

## **CIT Supports Local Homeless Children**

The Children in Transition program at Groveland Elementary is designed to help homeless children succeed in school. Children considered to be homeless include those sharing a house with another family due to financial hardship, as well as those living in motels, trailer parks, emergency shelters, cars, or similar environments.

#### How WE Can Help -

Zion has a long history of supporting the Groveland Elementary School CIT program. Throughout the year, we collect supplies that are needed on a daily basis by the children and their families. Donations of the following items are needed: paper towels, toilet tissue, Kleenex tissue, dish soap, bar soap, body wash, wash cloths, hairbrushes, combs, toothpaste, toothbrushes, detergent, shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, and all types of cleaning products.
