

#### Zion's Church Council Needs YOUR Input!

Fall is traditionally a time of change and newness for many schools, churches, and other organizations; this is certainly proving to be true at Zion. Our hard-working Church Council will be meeting this coming Sunday, Sept. 12, immediately following the Sunday worship service, to carefully consider 'next steps' in safely transitioning from previous Covid-19 restrictions to a return to our more traditional worship experience. Discussion will focus on 3 key considerations:

- Returning to congregational singing of some portions of the liturgy, i.e., Kyrie, Canticle of Praise, Gospel Acclamation, Great Thanksgiving, Communion and/or others.
- Increasing the number of verses of each hymn to be sung.
- Resuming our traditional Sunday coffee hour with refreshments, as well as other church family fellowship gatherings.

Council President Mike Harrass has stressed that YOUR input is vital during this process. He has asked that you please contact any one of Zion's Council members to share your thoughts and opinions on the proposed changes.
