For those that want to help prepare for the day and or work the day of, here is the schedule...

- The sauce crew will be starting the sauce process on **Friday October 29th around 9:00 am...** and continuing the next day, **Saturday Oct. 30th at 6:00am.**
- We will be making some meatballs on Friday, October 29th and the rest **Saturday, October 30th** in the cafeteria starting at **9am.** We will be spaced out throughout the room. Keep in mind that we are doing less than the amount as usual on Saturday and only half of them are being done in the cafeteria so as to maximize spacing/distancing.
- **Monday night (Nov 1st)** we will need lots of muscle to swing those pots and precooked pasta. We will also be setting up stations in the cafeteria for takeout and deliveries for the next day, all starting at 5:00pm.
- **Spaghetti Supper Day (Tuesday Nov 2nd)**...there will be volunteer jobs both inside and outside. Working the take out stations in the cafeteria, working outside with traffic flow for pickups, and of course doing deliveries.

In this vein we can't stress enough our understanding of the importance of staying within your comfort level. If you are not comfortable coming down and helping physically, we remind you that support can come in many forms...sponsoring and donating, (notes will be enclosed in each take out, and signage with your name or company name will be posted outside the school where orders will be picked up). 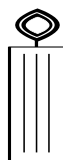

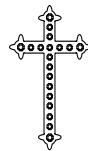
