We will be making meatballs on **Saturday, October 31st** in the cafeteria starting at 9 am. We will be spaced out throughout the room. Keep in mind that we are not doing anywhere near the same amount as we usually do and only half of them will be being done in the cafeteria. The next day the guys will be making sauce and on Monday night (Nov 2) we will need lots of muscle to swing those pots and precooked pasta. We will also be setting up stations in the cafeteria for takeout and deliveries for the next day all starting at 5.

Spaghetti Supper Day (Tuesday Nov. 3rd)..there will be volunteer jobs both inside and outside. Working the take out stations in the cafeteria, working outside with traffic flow for pickups, and of course doing deliveries.
