But the righteous shall be glad; they shall exult before God; they shall be jubilant with joy!

Psalm 68:3

"Betcha can't eat just one." The Frito-Lay Co. introduced this slogan for its Lay's Potato chips in the 60's. It is a memorable advertising campaign because it presents a challenge, maybe even a dare. Frito-Lay is saying that its chips are so good, it is impossible to eat just one. Barbecue flavor? Betcha can't eat just one. Sour cream & onion? Betcha can't eat just one.

God our heavenly Father could issue us, his children, a similar challenge: Betcha can't not have joy. Okay, it doesn't really roll off your tongue, but it's true. As a child of God, we were made for joy. King David tells us so in the above Psalm.

But this joy, this jubilation, is reserved for one type of people: the righteous. Do you count yourself among the righteous? Do you get lost in your selfish ways, chasing after worldly desires and fleeting happiness? Ever find yourself putting all your trust in things you think will bring you joy: professional success, material possessions, popularity, children, or hobbies?

Our sins have a way of deceiving us and snatching happiness away, just when it seems within reach. But the righteousness we need, and unsurpassable joy that accompanies it, comes through a relationship with God, our Creator. And we can have that relationship only through Jesus. In our sin, we were separated from God, but Jesus' work on the cross has brought us back, redeemed us, and made us righteous by faith in his name!

Dear Parents, Guardians, Students, Teachers and Parishioners.

Father Daniel Caruso and I come to you with deep concerns and a revised **Religious Education Program for the 2021-22 school year.**

Due to the significant increases in COVID-19/ Variant cases in Onondaga County, especially among children, we feel the need to restructure the program for the protection and safety of all involved. Consequently, we will be returning to the format followed last year.

On-site teaching will be only for those in sacramental classes. That includes 2nd graders receiving First Penance and First Communion, 9th graders beginning the first year of the Confirmation program and 10th graders completing the Confirmation program and receiving the sacrament in the spring of 2022. Details will follow and classes will begin at the end of October.

All other classes will resume at home using the literature sent home last year along with family prayer and discussion. Remember your children's primary teachers are you their parents. Contact the Parish Office at 315-422-7163 if additional literature is needed.

Hopefully the vaccine for those 12 and under will be available after the first of the year and we can look into a short spring session. Thank you for your patience and understanding in this matter.

As you can imagine, we have had 'Spaghetti Supper on the mind' around the office with lots of discussion! We have also met with our committee and spoken to County leaders and have come up with the decision to modify our traditional Election Day Spaghetti Supper again this year. And rest assured we are again taking every precaution to keep each other and our patrons safe.

The 72nd Annual Election Day Spaghetti Supper is Tuesday, Nov.2nd from 11 am to 6:00pm. As we did last year, we will be doing **Take Out and Delivery in a very large way!!** The price for individual take outs will be the same as the past few years..\$10.00, and we are again offering half trays that serve a generous portion for 6 (spaghetti, meatballs, salad, loaf of bread, and dessert) for \$50.00. Full trays that serve a generous portion for at least 15 for \$100.00. This worked out wonderfully last year as we sold out the 1000 meals we planned for a week before the event. This year we are planning to double the amount of dinners available from last year by preparing for 2000. We are also planning on a limited number of outdoor seating from 11:30 to 2:30 only!! Starting October 1st we will begin to take orders for Take Outs and Deliveries like last year, as well as the limited amount of outdoor seating.

Remember, we will be serving only 2000 meals total so get your reservations in! All meals will be packaged in "to go" containers, (even the outdoor seating)!

We want to thank everyone that are continuing their incredible support for this all important fundraiser. Sponsors, donors, volunteers...Thank you!!! In this vein be assured we respect everyone's comfort level. So please remember, support can come in many forms...sponsoring and donating, (notes will be enclosed in each take out, and signage with your name or company name will be posted outside the school where orders will be picked up). Helping in the kitchen making sauce, meatball making (Oct. 30th), prepping Monday night before, then the day of...working the take out stations in the cafeteria, working outside with traffic flow, helping for pickups and out door seating, doing deliveries, or just as important....by ordering take out and spreading the 'take out word' to family, friends and coworkers.

If we have not sold out beforehand we will also have a designated area for drive up orders, however pre- orders will have a specific location on site as to minimize your wait time.
