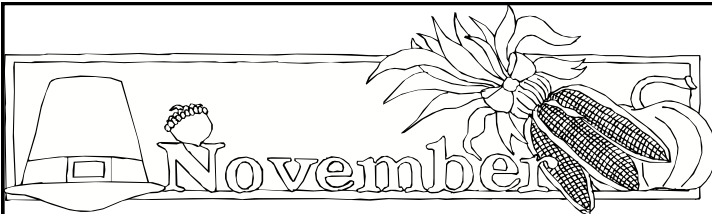
**Prayer For All Souls
