

Reminder: A Special Message about Christmas

Christmas is less than two months away and in this year in which nothing is “normal”, it’s not too early to begin to plan for a Christmas that is going to be very different from what we are used to. With the restrictions still in place to facilitate social distancing in church, we will not be able to accommodate the normal size congregations that usually join us at Christmas. In order to be able to seat as many people as possible, and to allow everybody an opportunity to reserve a seat, we will be using the following guidelines:

1. You can call to reserve a seat beginning Monday, November 30th at 9:00 am.
2. You will call the Parish Office of the Church where the Mass is being celebrated.
3. You will need to provide the names and contact information of all members in your group that will be attending Mass.
4. We will assign you a seat in advance. This assignment will be based on the best use of the available seating in order to accommodate the most people. It cannot be based on your preference. We ask for your understanding.
5. If all available seating is assigned before Christmas, only those who signed up in advance will be admitted into the Church for Mass.
