Fourth Sunday of Lent



On Jesus' Terms

Reflection: Starting the fourth week of Lent, the Lectionary sends us to the Gospel of John for the remainder of the season. This Gospel has several particular features, one of which is the careful enumeration of "signs" that Jesus performs that signal his identity as God's Son who came to bring life to the world. Today's reading alludes to the first sign, Jesus' changing water into wine at a wedding in Cana..

Jesus is now back at Cana, where he will perform his second sign. A royal official hears about Jesus and travels a good distance to seek healing for his young son who is at the point of death. We can only imagine the father's anguish at his son' plight. What must his anguish have been upon hearing Jesus' initial response: "Unless you people see signs and wonders, you will not believe?"

Wait a minute! Aren't signs a good thing? Not when people demand them from Jesus. It is not our prerogative to set the terms for divine action in our lives. The mother of God realized this at the wedding when, after Jesus' seemingly off-putting retort—"Woman, how does your concern affect me?"—she exhorted the servers. "Do whatever *he* tells you" (John 2:4-5).

Tha royal official learns a similar lesson. He has to let go of his expectation that Jesus will accompany him home to heal. Jesus simply says, "You may go; your son will live." Trusting Jesus' healing power, the man returns by himself, and discovers on the way that his son has been healed. He thereby models a difficult but important lesson: sometimes we must let go and, with trust, let God be God.

Prayer: God, I do not ask for anything today. I don't need any signs or wonders. I trust in you, and that is enough.


