Relics of St. Bernadette will visit the Cathedral on May 29th

The Diocese of Syracuse will host the relics of St. Bernadette of Lourdes Saturday, May 28— Tuesday, May 31. Three parishes including the Cathedral, will host the relics.

They will arrive at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception on Sunday, May 29.

The relics will arrive at Holy Family Church in Fairmount late in the day on Saturday, May 28. On Monday, May 30, they will be at Sacred Heart Parish in Cicero. They will then go back to Holy Family on Tuesday, May 31.

This will be the first time the relics of Saint Bernadette will be in the United States and part of a tour that will run through August. Central New York and New York City are the only New York State sites on the tour.

Responding to the invitation of many, including Bishop Lucia, Sanctuary of Our Lady of Lourdes in France organized the pilgrimage in partnership with North American Lourdes Volunteers based in Syracuse, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, Hospitalite' of Miami and the Order of Malta.

How many of us remember wearing a Scapular?
In this month of May we honor Mary, the Blessed Mother.
If you haven't been invested in the scapular, Mary's month is a good time to do it. A scapular is basically a mini religious

habit for the laity, an outward symbol of your consecration to the Blessed Mother, that you wear daily underneath your clothes.

The original and most common scapular is the **Brown Scapular of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel** which has special prayers and graces associated with it, namely the famous "Scapular Promise" that those who die wearing Our Lady's scapular will not spend eternity in hell.
