Ten Good Reasons To Go To Mass

1. *God asks us to make one day holy.* We all need to refocus physically, mentally and spiritually. Going to Mass helps us to see everything from a different perspective.
2. *Jesus gives us the gift of himself.* When we go to Mass we are doing what Jesus commanded his followers to do.
3. *We need to be part of a community.* When we come together at Mass to pray and worship, we fulfill a deep need inside of us to be in communion with other people.
4. *God has a special message.* God speaks to us in a special way in the readings at Mass. We should be open to what the Lord is trying to tell us.
5. *We need to talk to God.* When we go to Mass, we speak to God through our singing, communal responses and prayers, and personal prayers from the depths of our hearts.
6. *People need prayers.* We pray for others anytime, but when we pray for others during Mass, we pray in a special way.
7. *We need to stand up for what we believe.* Being a follower of Jesus, we have the opportunity to stand up and proclaim what we believe together.
8. *We need to acknowledge that we make mistakes.* At every Mass, we have the opportunity to review the past week and admit that we have sinned.
9. *We need ritual in our lives.* Mass is a ritual, and we are formed, disciplined and consoled when we participate in the Mass.
10. *We need to experience something bigger than ourselves.* When we go to Mass, we share in the death and resurrection of Jesus. We enter into God's great plan when we offer our lives to God. We are strengthened by the Eucharist and sent out into the world to bring the Gospel message to all.

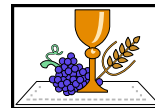


