COVID PROTOCOLS

- ◆ NYS and CDC regulations continue to maintain the wearing of masks for those not yet vaccinated. Masks for those who are fully vaccinated continue to be optional.
- ◆ A “physical distance section” within the church is the front section on the left side of church facing the Altar. Those not vaccinated or those who wish to be extra cautious may sit here.
- ◆ Holy Communion will continue to be distributed under the form of bread only.
- ◆ At the sign of Peace there still should be no physical contact.
- ◆ Holy Water Fonts will be filled.
- ◆ Hand sanitizer will continue to be available.

As you know, the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday and Holy Day Masses was lifted on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body of Christ, Sunday, June 6, 2021.

It should be noted as well that anyone who is frail or at risk due to advanced age or medical conditions is *always* excused from this obligation. Caregivers, too, may have to use prudential judgment about attendance at Mass, carefully considering the risk factors involved. Therefore, we will maintain livestreaming/recorded Masses for those who are still not able to be at Mass in person.

At the heart of the church is vocation. The earliest idea of what is today called “church” starts with the Greek word *ekklesia*, which is only found twice in the gospels, both times in Matthew, and means those who have been “called out.” Jesus “calls out” all who follow him to share in his ministry in different ways. Before Jesus even preached, healed someone, or performed a miracle, he called people to follow him. At the beginning of Jesus’ ministry, after his baptism and temptation in the wilderness, the first thing he did was to call two sets of brothers. He asks Simon and Andrew and then James and John to follow him (Mark 1:16-20). And that is the church in its simplest terms: the followers of Jesus Christ.

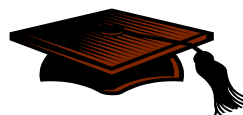
