### MADE TO SERVE



You've probably seen the comical fitness advertisements from the 1920s. A high-heeled lady stood on a platform with a vibrating belt around her backside. The jiggling belt promised to shake the lady's body into shape. All she had to do was stand there!

You may be surprised to know that these vibrating fitness machines have come a long way in the past century. Yes, they do still exist. But are they any more effective than the odd-looking belt from way back when? Medical experts say, "No."

The reason is pretty logical: if you want the benefits of exercise, you have to move your body.

A similar connection exists between our faith and good works: our faith moves us to serve. Our Christian walk is dull and lifeless if we sit idle. God created our hearts and bodies to move, to step out in service!

No, your heavenly Father made you to use your faith in service each and every day!

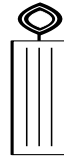
We all grow weary in service. Even Jesus grew tired as he served people during his earthly ministry.
