Ash Wednesday. First day of Lent.

Ashes from burnt palms placed on the forehead as a sign of penance. Ash Wednesday is a day of abstinence from meat and fasting--one regular meal and two smaller meals that together don't equal a full meal. The 40-day period represents Christ's time of temptation in the wilderness, where he fasted and where Satan tempted him. Lent asks us to set aside time to focus on Christ's life, ministry, sacrifice and resurrection.


