Dear Parishioners,

I pray that this Holy Season of Lent is going well for all of us at Our Lady of Pompei/St. Peter and St. John the BaptistHoly Trinity. Daily Mass is another excellent way to help us to focus on our spiritual life. I know it is not always easy to make it to daily Mass, but the sacrifice we make can be part of the Lenten journey. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the "source and summit" of our Faith. What a wonderful gift to give God (and ourselves) if we could attend daily Mass at least once a week during Lent. Our Lady of Pompei/St. Peter has daily Mass Tuesday - Thursday at 9:00 AM in the Chapel and Friday at 12:15 PM during Lent. Daily Mass is celebrated at St. John the Baptist/ Holy Trinity on Monday, Tuesday, and Friday at Noon.

of the Cross Lenten experience. Many of us have gotten away from reflecting on the difficult road that Jesus walked for us. It is important for us to remember because we are asked to follow in His footsteps. 
