January Meeting Agenda Items

Every January the Club holds it Annual Planning Meeting, during which our members have loads of input.

We transition to new officers after an election year, our board positions are 2-year terms; but 2025 starts the second of two-years for the current board, so this won't be applicable. BUT next year, there will be a entirely new board, as none of the current volunteers plan to run again at this time. (NOTE: start thinking about which position best fits your skills. Shadowing ahead of time will give you insight about what the position entails!)

The main emphasis, however, is on our charities. A vote will be taken to decide <u>how many</u> charities we want to **financially** support in 2025. We can also decide to support to other groups throughout the year, in the form of manpower by participation by manning raffle tables, walking at their events. Separate from that we can also coordinate food or supplies donations—think collections after a catastrophic act of nature, food banks, animal shelters, or other local opportunities. We even donated 31 (old inventory) club shirts to the Helene efforts this year!

All members are invited to nominate a charity that we will support in the coming year. Either you or a representative of the group are asked to present a little about what it is that they do (who, what, why, where and when—how if it's not obvious.) Once all charities have been presented, and all questions answered, each member present gets to vote for their choice by a show of hands. The agreed upon number of charities are then chosen based on those results.

IF you nominate a 501(c)3 and it is selected, you automatically become the chair of that committee. As chair, you become the liaison between the club and the organization, spearhead any joint efforts on their behalf, and organize our members who participate. It's not difficult and allows you to have an important impact on our community.
