Creativity has always been my language, the way I make sense of the world, connect with others, endure, and give back.

For nearly twenty years, I built my career in the United States as an art educator working at the intersection of fashion, costume, and education. Throughout that journey, one belief guided me: art transforms people, and people, when given the right space, transform communities.

Returning home to Montréal brought that belief into sharper focus. With distance came clarity; with return came purpose. I am my truest self in the studio – where music plays softly, hands remain busy, stories unfold naturally, and creativity moves at a human pace. Studio.Art.Lab grows from that feeling and from a desire to open that space outward.

Through years of working with youth, adults, newcomers, seniors, and differently paced learners, I have learned something essential: talent is everywhere – access is not.

I have witnessed lives shift through simple acts: sewing a seam, threading a needle, sketching a silhouette. I have also seen who is too often excluded from creative spaces – those told they are “too old” to begin, those who learn differently, those who do not see themselves reflected, and those who need art not as enrichment, but as healing.

Studio.Art.Lab was born to create the space that did not yet exist – accessible, inclusive, communal, and profoundly human. A third space. A place where youth, adults, and seniors gather around a shared table of making and storytelling. A place to exist, explore, listen, and grow through process. The ARC Gala is the first public step in bringing this vision to life.

This evening is more than a fashion event. It is a declaration of what creativity becomes when we center Access, Resilience, and Community – where couture meets purpose, storytelling becomes empowerment, and the runway opens pathways to possibility.

Funds raised through the ARC Gala will secure the foundation of Studio.Art.Lab and launch after-school, evening, and community-based programming. This support will open doors for youth seeking identity, adults returning to creativity, seniors rediscovering joy, newcomers building belonging, and creators with diverse learning profiles who deserve thoughtfully designed spaces.

My vision is a creative hub where people of all ages and abilities are welcomed not as outsiders, but as makers, artists, storytellers, and contributors to Montréal's cultural future. A place where creativity builds confidence, where roots become wings, and where community grows through shared experience.

Elisabetta Polito is a Montréal-based costume and fashion designer, educator, and founder of Studio.Art.Lab and STUDIO VIEMAGE, twin practices rooted in craft, culture, and creative power. Through VIEMAGE, her work moves between textile traditions and sculptural construction, translating personal narrative into garments and installations that live in the tension of opposites: strength/softness, gold/shadow, heritage/reinvention.

At Studio.Art.Lab, Elisabetta is building a bilingual micro-school and community incubator where art and design education is radically accessible, emotionally intelligent, and deeply inclusive. The Lab's hands-on workshops, mentorship, and interdisciplinary courses center responsive pedagogy and welcome creators of every age and learning profile—including neurodivergent artists and those with diverse abilities—to think critically, make boldly, and connect meaningfully.

Elisabetta holds two BFAs, an MFA, and an M.Ed., and is currently pursuing a PhD. Her research explores how making fosters identity, resilience, and social change, especially for learners who don't fit traditional molds. With 10+ years leading award-winning fashion and textile programs, she has mentored hundreds of emerging creators across North America.

Whether onstage, in studio, or in community, her work begins from a simple conviction: creativity isn't just a craft, it's a language of healing, empowerment, belonging, and transformation.

WHY THE ARC GALA EXISTS

ARC Gala was born from a simple and urgent belief: creativity should belong to everyone – every age, every ability, every background.

In Montréal, countless young people and adults dream of exploring fashion, textile arts, and creative expression, yet lack the access, confidence, or safe spaces to begin. Traditional art environments can feel intimidating, exclusive, or out of reach. ARC Gala exists to rewrite that story.

WHERE ACCESS MEETS IMAGINATION **PHILOSOPHY**

Studio.Art.Lab was envisioned as more than a workspace or a school, it was imagined as a creative home:

- A home for textile arts, fashion design, craft-based learning, and interdisciplinary exploration.
- A home for people who seek community as much as instruction.
- A home for stories too often overlooked, unheard, or uncelebrated.
- It is a place built with intention, where individuals come not only to learn, but to unfold, to connect, and to discover who they can become through the act of making.

ACCESS

- means redesigning the entire creative experience so that no one feels excluded – financially, culturally, physically, emotionally, or educationally.

- means creating a vibrant, interconnected creative ecosystem where people of all ages, cultures, and abilities come together to learn, share, and belong.

Here, creativity is shared, exchanged, and expanded – woven through relationships as much as through materials.

Our aim: to make Studio.Art.Lab a home for makers—a place where people don't just learn to make art, they learn to author their own narratives.



STUDIO EXPERIENCE	DESCRIPTION
PUPPET & CHARACTER DESIGN	Students design and build a puppet using fabric, yarn, and mixed materials. This lesson explores storytelling, texture, and emotional expression while strengthening fine motor skills.
TEXTILE COLLAGE & SURFACE DESIGN	Students create layered textile collages using fabric scraps and thread. The focus is on composition, texture, and visual storytelling through materials.
INTRODUCTORY EMBROIDERY	Students learn basic embroidery stitches and apply them to fabric panels. Emphasis is placed on patience, rhythm, and intentional mark-making rather than technical perfection.
PUNCH NEEDLE EXPLORATION	Students explore punch needle as a tactile, repetitive technique that supports focus and sensory engagement. Designs range from abstract to symbolic depending on age group.
DESIGNING A BAG OR POUCH	Students plan, decorate, and construct a functional bag or pouch, learning how creativity connects to structure, use, and thoughtful decision-making.
FASHION SKETCHING & IDEATION	Students explore how ideas move from concept to design through guided sketching, mood-building, and early fashion illustration exercises.
TEXTURE MAPPING & SENSORY DESIGN	Students explore texture through touch-based exercises, creating samples that contrast smooth, rough, soft, and layered materials.
SHOE OR ACCESSORY PROTOTYPING	Using cardboard, foam, and fabric, students design and prototype a shoe or accessory concept, emphasizing experimentation, structure, and problem-solving.
MATERIAL STUDIES: SOFT STRUCTURES	Students investigate how soft materials hold form through folding, layering, and stitching, exploring balance, structure, and construction.
STORY CLOTHS & NARRATIVE TEXTILES	Students create textile pieces that tell a story or represent a memory, idea, or place, connecting making with narrative and personal meaning.
DECORATIVE PANELS & WALL HANGINGS	Students design a textile panel intended for display, focusing on composition, repetition, and intentional design choices.
FROM SKETCH TO OBJECT	Students develop an idea through sketching, material selection, making, and reflection, learning how creative ideas evolve over time.





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
