**ARMY BENEVOLENT FUND(ABF) DEVON CHARITY GOLF DAY:**  
**WEDNESDAY 28 JULY 2021**

1. The 2021 ABF Devon Charity Golf Day will again take place at Dainton Park Golf Club, Ipplepen, NEWTON ABBOT on **Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> Jul '21**. Teams are invited to take part. There will be two 18 Hole Bowmaker Stableford competitions: Men's Team of Three and Ladies' Team of Three off **full handicap** teeing off in teams of three. The programme for the day will be:

- a. Reception open **from 0830 hrs.**
- b. Coffee and bacon roll from the Bar once registered at Reception.
- c. Reserved tee **from 0930 hrs** onwards.
- d. Two course carvery supper plus coffee **from 1600 hrs** to include prize giving.

2. This programme is dependent upon the coronavirus having been brought to heel and any well intentioned government restrictions in the availability of Dainton Park Golf Club facilities having been lifted.

3. There will not be a central briefing. An A5 Briefing Sheet with all key points will be included with each player's score card to be collected at Reception. This Sheet will also be displayed on the Club Plasma Screen in the Bar. Any resulting questions to Trevor Ongley.

4. Competitions and Prizes:

- a. Men's Team of Three 18 Hole Bowmaker Stableford: Prizes for 1<sup>st</sup> + 2<sup>nd</sup> Teams(Yellow Tees)
- b. Ladies' Team of Three 18 Hole Bowmaker Stableford: Prizes for 1<sup>st</sup> + 2<sup>nd</sup> Teams(Red Tees).
- c. Golfers Lucky Dip Envelope: Cash Prizes for drawing a player who is a member of either of the Men's or Ladies' Winning Team.
- d. Waterloo Putting Challenge: Prize for Lowest Score.
- e. Nearest THE Gin(NG)(7<sup>th</sup> Hole): Prize for Winner only.
- f. Beat the Pro(BP)(8<sup>th</sup> Hole): Prize for Winner to be drawn at prize giving from Pro's list of those who have succeeded.
- g. Nearest the Line(NL)(11<sup>th</sup> Hole): Prize for Winner only.
- h. Longest Drive(LD)(12<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> Holes): Prize for both Men & Ladies' Winners.
- j. Nearest the Bull(NB)(13<sup>th</sup> Hole): Prize for Winner only.
- k. Nearest Pin(NP)(15<sup>th</sup> Hole): Prize for both Men & Ladies' Winners.
- l. David Knight Memorial Challenge(4<sup>th</sup>,8<sup>th</sup>,15<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>): Lowest individual combined gross score for these Par 3s.

m. Various Reward and Consolation Prizes.

5. The Golfers Lucky Dip Envelope is a competition costing £5 per player(included in the cost for the day) which buys a sealed unmarked envelope on arrival at Reception which contains the name of one of the golfers playing that day. If that name is a member of either the Men's or Ladies' Winning Team then you will be rewarded with a cash prize.

6. The Waterloo Putting Challenge costs £1 per player(included in the cost for the day). This competition on the carefully reset practice putting green is a gentle reminder that both pace and line will be needed later. Similarly, the Beat the Pro competition costs £1 per player(included in the cost for the day). Those surpassing the Pro's shot to the green will be entered in a draw to take place during the prize giving.

7. The aim is to again have an enjoyable day on this beautiful golf course and partake of the Club's excellent bar and dining facilities whilst also raising money for **ABF Devon**. Please note that both the Men's and Ladies' Team of Three 18 Hole Bowmaker Stableford competitions will be **the two best scores of three to count**. Individuals not bringing others to make up a team of three are asked to nominate on the Application Form with whom they would like to play.

8. The cost for the day will be £48 for non members and £29 for members. This covers coffee and bacon roll on arrival, 18 holes of golf, Golfers Lucky Dip Envelope, both the Waterloo Putting Challenge and Beat the Pro plus a 2 course carvery supper with coffee.

Those wishing to play should complete the Application Form enclosed and return it to me at my home address shown at the top of the Form. **Applications close at COP Sun 25<sup>th</sup> Jul 21.** *I would very much appreciate early receipt of your completed Application Forms to enable me to assess support for the event and thus plan tee timings, catering and prizes. Payment can be made either in advance along with your Application Form, by BACS if so desired or simply on the day at Reception.*

10. Players wishing to bring a spouse, partner or friend to the carvery supper at a cost of only £12 per person should indicate their requirements when completing the Application Form. Similarly, those wishing to reserve a buggy(at a special discounted price of £20) should indicate such on the Application Form.
