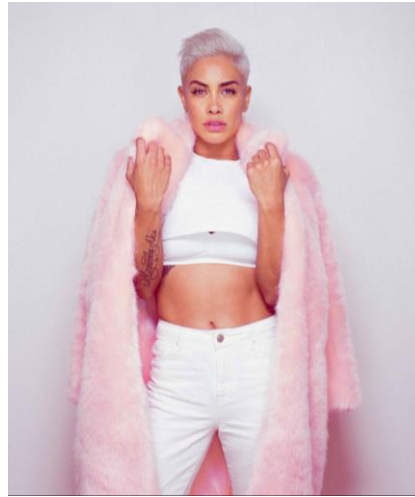


Feeding the homeless
