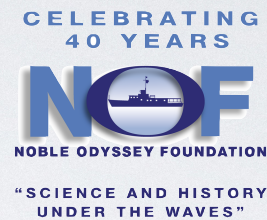

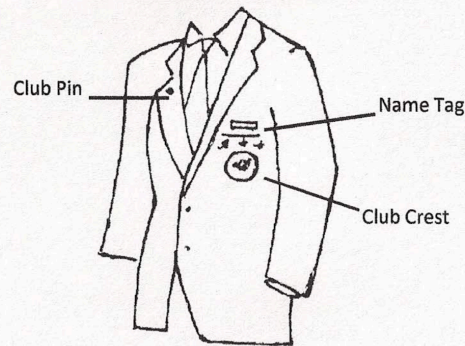
Winter Blues

October 1 thru April 30

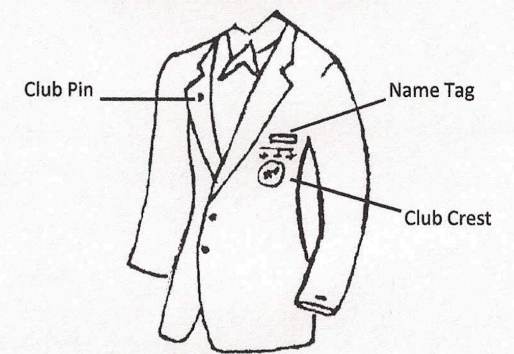
Men: Dark blue (Navy) Blazer, white shirt, black tie & dark grey pants.

Woman's Winter Uniform



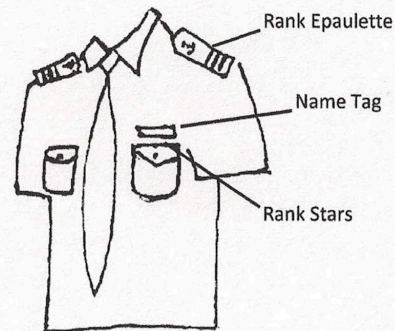
Summer Whites

May 1 thru September 30

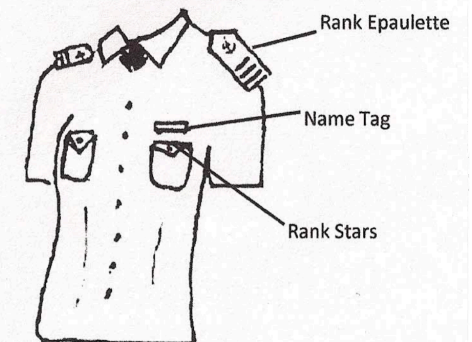
Men: white shirt w/ranking Epaulette, white slacks (shorts), white shoes & black tie
