- All Cabinets are constructed with 3/4" Finished Maple Plywood screwed together at the joints.
- We use only *Water Bourne Finish* products. These have no VOC's. They provide a safer environment for your home and a safer workplace for our employees. Very few companies do this.
- A Quality Finish that is the finest in the industry. We do our own finishes in our shop.
- Plywood shelves with real wood edges.
- Plywood Toe Kicks that are separate from the cabinet box, so moisture is never transferred into the cabinet box construction.
- Solid Wood Face Frames Screwed together at all joints.
- Solid Wood Maple Nailers are a part of our Upper Cabinet construction used to secure them to the wall.
- Wood Dovetailed Drawer Boxes and Pullout Shelves.
- Blum Under Mount Full Extension 100lb Soft Close Drawer Guides included on all of our Drawers and Pullout Shelves. Blum is the leader in the Drawer Guide Industry.
- Blum 110-degree Soft Close Hinges with six-way adjustments are included on all of our doors.
- Solid Wood Framed Doors and Drawer Fronts in over a hundred popular styles and any wood species. Painted Doors and Face Frames are made of Maple not Alder or Poplar as many companies do.

- All screws used in installing the upper and tall cabinets are capped to match the cabinet interior. Only the best cabinet companies do this.
- A scheduled final touch-up after the flooring and counter tops are installed to assure that everything is completed.
