**We use the following products and/or applications:**

\*NOTE: We both grow and process our tea here on the farm. As such, we treat more fragile greenhouse stock seedlings differently than we do for fully mature, harvesting plants in the field. For example, we use liquid fertilizer for nursery plants, but use granular in the field. These distinctions are noted below.

Hillbilly Yaupon: 100% natural, wild-crafted, nothing added.

20-10-20 Soluble Fertilizer Plus Minors. Used only with greenhouse seedlings to establish healthy root structure before planting in the field.

Other Teas (listed):

8-10-10. Granular, slow-release fertilizer. Applied as a top soil dressing 3-4x per year to field plants to establish roots and promote healthy foliage.

Bifenthrin (in plants <5 years old). Aphid control. Similar to organic pyrethrin, but with slightly longer duration for aphid prevention. Applied 1x/month in Spring/Summer. Timed to wash off with rains before harvest. Please note that we use Bifenthrin only on the younger plants to help them get established. Once mature (>5yr), we switch over to pyrethrin as necessary.

Pyrethrin (in plants >5 years old). Organic aphid control. See 'bifenthrin' above.

Captan. Antifungal. Applied 3x/year. Water soluble, timed to wash off with rains before harvest. Captan is a very safe antifungal that biodegrades with a halflife of less than 1 day in soil.
