Please be blessed by the testimony of Dave Lenzi.

When I was young I went to a Catholic church with my parents and grandparents. I attended their Catechism school and was confirmed in 1973. These were my first memorized prayers: The Lord's Prayer and The Hail Mary prayer. But it was not until 1998 when I was baptized a Baptist that I really started my religious journey.

Unfortunately, I backslid in my relationship with God thereafter until 2003. Not that my faith diminished - I was just going to church "to go." In 2003 the Lord had a new race ready for me that changed my life and continues to this day. I got my first cancer diagnosis. Later, in 2008, I lost my first kidney and in 2022, I lost the other. Between these years I've had knee replacements, colon surgery, back surgery, wrist surgery, chemo and radiation treatments for cancer. The main reason I can write this testimony today is my Savior Jesus Christ pulled me through all of these life-threatening health situations! The more my trials, the closer I got to God through Jesus Christ and He guided the way. The Lord made such an impression on me during these trials I could not stop reading the Bible and learning about Him. So, in 2022 I went back to school (at 63) and studied the Word during my recoveries and dialysis treatment times. All I can say is, I wish I knew Jesus in my younger years. Sure, I knew of Jesus, but I really did not know him as I do now.

What a great feeling to be able to have a relationship with our creator Jesus Christ. I have been blessed in more ways than I can list. God's grace has shined on me! As Pastor Dalton tells me,
"Keep your eyes on Jesus."
