MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES MAGNIFIED!

God is truly blessing Salt Creek Baptist Church! One visible evidence of this truth is the Keith Marshall Activity Center. This will house our youth department and provide a covered area for various activities. Our children's department is growing and thriving. In the week prior to Easter, two previously unoccupied rooms were structured to accommodate 34 children ages Kindergarten – 5^{tth} grade on Resurrection Sunday. Our nursery and preschool areas also underwent expansion for the babies, toddlers, and preschoolers who fill our hearts and our rooms.

Because a "normal" Sunday morning brought 256 precious souls to our worship service, additional chairs were added to comfortably seat all who chose to attend our church. In addition, a "live stream feed" was installed so our faithful members could watch the service from the fellowship hall; thus, allowing our visitors room in the sanctuary. Screens were installed so announcements could be viewed prior to our weekly Sunday services. This new software also provides the ability to play videos during any special event – such as "Celebrations of Life" and "Senior Recognition Sundays." Our Wednesday Men and Women's Bible Studies are growing weekly. The prayer meeting group, who faithfully join together in voicing prayer concerns and words of praise, seems to increase each Wednesday as well.

With these many praiseworthy blessings come opportunities to serve. Since the time of Jesus, this Truth has been relevant: "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few..."
