**SALT CREEK MUSIC MINISTRY**

Our music ministry at Salt Creek is led by Randy and Melinda Ethridge who came to Salt Creek as music minister and pianist in 2002. Randy works with pastor Dalton to select songs for Sunday mornings that complement the sermon topics and he coordinates the "special music" presentations by our folks for each Sunday as well, all in an effort to make our Sunday mornings a worshipful and uplifting time for all. The goal of the music ministry team is to create an environment on Sunday mornings that enhances the worship experience and the preaching of God's word. Music is also used to minister to the souls of our people during times of difficulty, such as funerals. Another subset of the music ministry is the audio/video ministry, which strives to provide quality recordings of our Sunday morning worship times that are edited and placed on YouTube weekly so that our members who are unable to attend in person can still experience corporate worship.

We enjoy singing the old hymns as a congregational at Salt Creek, with a variety of "specials" by individuals or groups on Sunday mornings that range from bluegrass gospel to current contemporary Christian. The Salt Creek choir, now the biggest and best it has ever been, gathers on Sunday mornings in the choir loft to lead in congregational singing, and also works several months each fall to present a cantata during the Christmas season that is much anticipated and enjoyed by our members. What makes every part of the music ministry good at Salt Creek is the same thing that makes SCBC good as a whole - its people, and their desire to serve the Lord! We want to encourage our folks to use the talents God gave them in these ministry areas to His glory and to the benefit of their fellow members! The music ministry is blessed with talented singers and musicians, and there is ALWAYS room for more!
