September 2025

\$72,000 - State of Florida Matching Grant Program: Two Proposals Okaloosa Public Schools Foundation in partnership with the Consortium of Florida Education Foundation

- The Instructional Impact: Tools, Training, and Transformation grant advances a school district's initiative to strengthen teaching quality and student outcomes through mini-grants for classroom innovation, targeted support for science assessment alignment, and onboarding resources for new educators.
- The Student Success and Readiness Initiative delivers targeted academic support, career exposure, and hands-on STEM and CTE experiences to close skill gaps and prepare students for graduation and postsecondary success.

August 2025

\$10,000 - NEXTera Energy Foundation Building STEM Minds: Trades & Tech for Tomorrow Okaloosa Public Schools Foundation

This grant builds on the success of last year's Building MATH Skills initiative by
expanding hands-on math and science enrichment to five Title I elementary schools,
targeting fragile learners in grades 1–5. Younger students will engage in roboticsbased science activities, while older students will continue developing math skills
through construction-based learning.

\$7,900 – Florida Power & Light EmPOWERing STEM Educators Grant Okaloosa Public Schools Foundation in partnership with the Consortium of Florida Education Foundation

 This grant supports Algebra I teachers with funding for substitute teachers, materials, stipends, and peer collaboration training to enable them to conduct Instructional Rounds for improved teaching and learning opportunities for the 2025-2026 school year.
