Programming settings prior to dash camera first use

Step 1:

Download GNET app to your mobile device and follow steps for connection as per "Quick Guide for connecting a G-NET Dash camera via the G-Net App" instructions.

Step 2:

Select "Real-Time Video" – check and correct camera angles on dash camera to ensure best angle of vision.




Step 3:

Enter into **Settings** screen on the App and ensure the following settings are saved in each section.

Step 4: Camera

Front – Resolution 4k UHD, Event 30fps, Normal 30fps, night vision on.

IMPORTANT set Event prior to setting normal Rear – Resolution 1080p, FHD,



Step 5: Voltage Management

LBP – On

It is very important to ensure the power off setting is set according to the battery type in the vehicle.


Step 9: Time


Step 10: Memory

Memory ratio - Integrated recording, Overwrite - On




Step 11: Information


Driver information - optional Car information - optional (eg - registration plate or make/model of vehicle). Ensure save is pressed on input screen if you wish to enter these details.




Step 12:

Press back arrow on settings screen to go back to home page of app and save changed settings. Some models will now restart themselves.





Once setup is completed, ensure the Wi-Fi connection is disconnected and forgotten. Go to Wi-Fi settings on your phone and select 'info' and then select 'Forget This Network'

After the unit has reset, it is recommended that you go back into the settings and confirm that the settings have been saved.
