Resignation of the Prime Minister

Sir Keir Starmer must resign as Prime Minister this Saturday morning (ie the 14th). This is because he has acted illegally over a long period of time and has dishonestly and repeatedly misled the country about himself and his true character. If he does not resign all his public positions he must announce personally and publicly on Monday morning that he will issue High Court proceedings against me for Defamation due to me writing and publishing that he is a "fraudster". My principal defence in such proceedings would be that what I say is true in fact and law. Please see my letter of 10 December to Sir Keir (ie the first of the attachments to this letter, and the other pages).

There is a need for this correspondence to be circulated to members of the Cabinet (and the UK Law Officers) as this matter has to be resolved without further delay. There will be a need at some point over the weekend for an emergency Cabinet meeting to be held. I assume you will speak confidentially with the Cabinet Secretary who will be able to liaise with the King's Private Secretary and the Chief of the Defence Staff so as to ensure all resignation and temporary handover requirements are complied with properly.

Sir Keir Starmer has until 27 February 2025 to issue a Claim against me. However, he cannot act as doing so would, of itself, involve him committing an offence under the Fraud Act. He has been informed that he would face a counter-claim from me and an application for reasonable indemnity costs. As his offences involve frauds against The Crown, he cannot rely on any Government support whatsoever; anyone who assists him to evade accountability and liability will commit an offence. At the relevant time a report will be made by me to the SFO.

You personally will know that Sir Keir Stramer has acted dishonestly by: (a) misleading people to their loss/detriment; (b) not disclosing information to them in accordance with his legal duties; and (c) acting in abuse of position. That must be so in respect of you personally (as it was with Sue Gray and Louise Haigh) otherwise you and members of the "Arlington Group" and persons involved in Labour Together Ltd could be held criminally liable in respect of Joint Enterprise or for conspiracy to commit fraud. It speaks for itself that you would not (as reported) have thought Keir Starmer was a potential future Labour Party Leader and Prime Minister if you had been aware of his prior criminality. You will understand that the same applies to all the donors and supporters who believed him when he said he had no "skeletons" in his closet.
