The Grassroots Points League will be run according to BRC rules found in the current BRC Handbook.

- 1. Individuals can compete in Show Jumping 50cm & 60cm competitions and Cross-Country 60-70cm (including Arena Eventing, Hunter Trials and ODE).
- It is the individuals' responsibility to download and print this points card and produce it at every relevant competition to gain the signature of the Secretary upon being placed.
- The Grassroots league commences on 1 January and will run until the end of October in the same year. Completed points cards must be returned to BRC Head Office no later than 7th of the following month. Results on cards received after this time will not count.
- Checks will be carried out by BRC HQ to ensure that the information provided is correct
- 5. Individuals can compete at any BRC Riding Club organised event. Area Qualifiers and National Level competitions will not count.
- 6. Individuals can compete across all Clubs and Areas.
- 7. If the points card is not filled out correctly the results will not be counted.
