

BEFORE STARTING YOUR ON-FARM ACTIVITY, YOU ARE REQUIRED TO READ THE POSTED WARNING TO VISITORS AND VISITOR RESPONSIBILITIES SIGNS TO LEARN ABOUT:

- The risks inherent to participating in on-farm activities; and
- Your responsibilities when participating in the activities on this working farm.

THE WARNING TO VISITORS SIGN IS POSTED AT THE FIELD ENTRANCE UNDER THE GAZEBO.

This sign identifies the inherent risk(s) of the on-farm activities in which you will be participating – activities that may expose you to the risk of personal injury, death or damage to your property.

THE VISITOR RESPONSIBILITIES SIGN IS POSTED AT THE FIELD ENTRANCE UNDER THE GAZEBO.

This sign describes your responsibilities as a visitor on a working farm, which include: obeying directional and “off limits” signs, following instructions and obeying warnings from farm representatives; complying with posted rules of conduct; and exercising reasonable care concerning disclosed risks.

- If you do not understand the information contained in the Warning to Visitors or Visitor Responsibilities signs or have any questions about their content, please ask a farm representative for help before you begin your on-farm activity. **If you do not see anyone, you may call (716) 201-8108 for the farm owner.**
- If you are accompanied by individuals who need help in understanding the inherent risks of participating in the on-farm activities or the responsibilities of a visitor on a working farm, please explain, or ask a farm representative to explain the risks and responsibilities to those people so that they understand them. **If you do not see anyone, you may call (716) 201-8108 for the farm owner.**

IF YOU (OR THOSE YOU ARE WITH) ARE UNPREPARED OR UNWILLING TO ACCEPT THE RISKS DISCLOSED OR THE RESPONSIBILITIES IMPOSED ON A VISITOR TO A WORKING FARM, PLEASE ADVISE THE ATTENDANT (or call (716) 201-8108) AND RETURN THE TICKET(S) INTACT AND UNUSED. YOU WILL BE ISSUED A REFUND FOR THE AMOUNT PAID FOR THE TICKET(S) WHEN FIRST ISSUED. IF YOU PAID IN CASH ON SITE PRIOR TO STARTING YOU-PICK, PLEASE CALL (716) 201-8108 TO HAVE YOUR MONEY RETURNED TO YOU.

WARNING TO VISITORS

PLEASE READ PRIOR TO BEGINNING YOUR YOU-PICK EXPERIENCE

INHERENT RISKS OF FARM ACTIVITIES

You are on a working flower farm. Participating in you-pick activities involves inherent risks, including but not limited to:

- Uneven, or slippery ground, holes, or tripping hazards.
- Insect bites or stings.
- Exposure to sun, heat, or weather conditions.
- Contact with plants, thorns, or allergens.
- Potential for minor cuts, scrapes, or strains while picking.
- Other risks associated with agricultural environments.

These risks may result in injury, illness, or in rare cases, more serious harm.

By entering and picking flowers, you voluntarily assume all these risks.

VISITOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Exercise reasonable care for your own safety and the safety of others (especially children).
- Stay in designated picking areas.
- Follow all posted rules and instructions.
- Supervise children at all times.
- Do not enter restricted or “employees only” areas.
- Some flowers may be toxic, monitor children to make sure they don’t put plants in their mouths.
- No dogs or other pets are permitted on our farm. Service animals are always welcome!

The farm is not liable for injuries resulting from the inherent risks of these activities if you fail to exercise reasonable care. *If you notice something that requires attention, please call (716) 201-8108 to let us know if you do not see us in the field.*

**BY ENTERING OUR FIELD, YOU ACKNOWLEDGE, UNDERSTAND, AND AGREE TO THE RISKS

INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOU-PICK CUSTOMERS:

1. Read all signage in its entirety before beginning your you-pick experience.
2. Grab one of the cups provided.
3. Add some water to the cup. You want your flowers to begin hydrating as soon as you cut them.
4. Grab a pair of snips – please do not utilize your own.
5. Enter the field and locate the flowers you would like to cut.
6. Strip off any foliage that would end up in the water. *Foliage sitting in the water will grow bacteria and decrease the life of your cut flowers.* You may leave the stripped foliage right on the ground where you are.
7. Clean up any garbage you may have and place in the appropriate receptacles at the you-pick entrance.
8. When you're done picking, please return your snips to the table under the gazebo, as well as a map of the field if you used one.
9. Be sure to pay on your way out! Our cash box and QR codes for Venmo/PayPal are posted on our barn.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- A first-aid kit is located under the gazebo with clear signage. Please use it if you need to.
- Complimentary bottles of bug spray and sunscreen can be found under the gazebo for your use. Please leave them for the customers after you.
- Garbage cans are located under the gazebo, we thank you for keeping our field clean and not littering.
- Some flowers are edible, some are TOXIC. We ask that you DO NOT consume your flowers unless you absolutely know what they are, and that they are safe. You may look to our website for more information on edible varieties.
- Some flowers are also toxic to pets. You've worked hard on your arrangement, please keep it out of your furry friends' reach.
