  2. Some things we will pass along the way: Polo fields, Adequan Global Dressage and Derby Field, 13500 South Shore Drive, and Palm Beach Equine Sports Complex.
  3. Pass by Wellington International equestrian showgrounds, home of the Winter Equestrian Festival and Dressage Competition, 3400 Equestrian Club Dr.
  4. View the beautiful homes and the Aero Club airplane runway on Takeoff Place.
  5. Stop to stretch your legs at Village Hall and see the Wellington Patriot Memorial which features an eternal flame that burns 24/7/365 as part of the tribute to the victims and heroes of the 9/11 attacks along with a massive steel beam from the World Trade Center, a waterfall, and window panes with the names of nearly 3,000 victims. The eternal flame symbolizes the remembrance of those who lost their lives during the attacks, 12198 Forest Hill Boulevard.
  6. On our way back to lunch, we will pass the Veteran's Monument on South Shore as well as the International Polo Club Palm Beach, the premiere polo destination of the world, 3667 120th Avenue South.
