

Board Election Policy and Procedure
Policy 215

Adopted by Naytahwaush Community Charter School Board: April 24, 2008

Revised: July 11, 2016

1. An election committee shall be formed at the March board of directors' meeting each year. Board members who are running for election are ineligible to serve on the committee.
2. Every parent/legal guardian whose contact information is on file at NCCS will be sent a ballot in April, along with NCCS employees and school board members.
3. Ballots will be due and collected at a specific time and date in May.
4. In the event of a tie, there will be a run-off election in May.
5. The Board will certify election results at the May board meeting. Run-off election results, if needed, will be certified at the June board meeting.
6. Newly elected board members may attend the June meeting, but will not be voting members until the July meeting.
