- ❖ To focus on Advocacy/Communication and structure for new goals:
 - ★ Create conditions district wide for students
 - → Students want more from Mahnomen school when transitioning to 7th grade. Possible shadowing program to start?
 - → Explore k5 option
 - → Student transportation safety (bus safety and behavior)
 - → Student basic needs are met (backpack program, caddies, etc.)
 - → Continue and expand student recognition program (PBIS Program to be implemented this year
 - → Strengthen school safety-visitors must state name and purpose
 - → Drug prevention, personal safety and wellness (look into better videos)

- → Expand and strengthen curriculum and teaching in order to increase student achievement as measured in MCA and FAST data (updated Math X this year and also all staff will attend the FAST meeting this year)
- ★ Engage local community and represent the values and expectations they hold for their schools
 - → Family Fun, reader theater, pow wow (comment box exit ticket with feedback)
 - → Surveys, parent advisory meetings
 - → Expand Ojibwe program (language expansion, local history and resources, elders sharing, respect for elders)

Two new goals were added this year:

1. We will create conditions district wide for student and staff success.

- → Monthly in person NCCS reports from special education, Ojibwe, intervention, assessment, etc.
- → Monitor and improve special education services for compliance.
- → Deepen cultural awareness training for staff.
- → Implement active supervision training and expectations for all staff.
- → Use board committees more often.
- → Collaborate with NCF for building expansion and improvement plans.
- → Expand and strengthen curriculum and teaching in order to increase student achievement as measured in MCA and FAST data by implementing FAST schoolwide.
- → Implement PBIS school-wide.
- → Survey NCCS graduates for advice on their preparation for academic and social for successful transition, visit other schools, shadow student for a full day.

2. We will engage local community and represent the values and expectations they hold for our school.

- → Use board committees more often.
- → Expand Ojibwe program (language expansion, local history and resources, elders sharing, respect for elders, seasonal activities, tribal government).
- → Family Fun, Readers Theater, pow wow, comment box.
- → Surveys, parent advisory meetings.
