- SPL-token payments confirmed through exchange logs.
- Reservation and schedule confirmations minted into timelocked receipts.
- Real-time tips, feedback, or donations minted into participation NFTs.

Application: A portion of every tokenized transaction flows into preparedness campaigns (festivals, drills, resilience hubs), ensuring safety is continuously funded by community activity.

11.1.2 Proof-of-Experience (PoX₂) — Memory as Preparedness

PoX₂ transforms presence into permanence. Attending a preparedness festival, joining a resilience drill, or completing a safety training becomes a minted badge—etched forever into

the chain of civic memory. These NFTs evolve with repetition, unlock lore, and tie safety into identity.

- Streak recognition for recurring participation (e.g., attending multiple drills).
- Seasonal badges tied to resilience weeks, awareness months, or cultural events.
- Hidden badges unlocked by assisting others or exploring community initiatives.

Application: Public safety campaigns—*Proof of Preparedness Week, Community Resilience Festivals*—reward participants with PoX₂ badges, immortalizing their vigilance as part of civic legacy.

11.1.3 Proof-of-Excellence (PoX₃) — Honoring the Guardians

PoX₃ recognizes those who serve: staff, volunteers, responders, and community leaders. These are soulbound tokens, non-transferable and permanently linked to an individual's record of care. They elevate unseen contributions into honored legacies.

- Guest-to-staff recognitions recorded in real time.
- Peer-to-peer acknowledgments for teamwork, precision, or empathy.

Seasonal awards for consistent excellence, curated by DAO governance.

Application: Responders in a crisis earn PoX₃ badges like *Proof-of-Resolve* or *Proof-of-Care*, permanently enshrining their service as civic legend.

11.1.4 Active Badge Series & Safety Applications

Per Diem's badge system blends artistic storytelling with practical resilience. Each badge becomes both a collectible and a functional tool in sustaining safety.

Examples of Safety-Oriented Badges & NFTs:

- Proof-of-Preparedness Attending civic drills or simulations.
- Proof-of-Resilience Completing recovery training or mental health workshops.
- Proof-of-Alertness Reporting hazards or suspicious behaviors.
- Proof-of-Service For staff who provide care during daily operations.
- Proof-of-Teamwork Awarded to groups who successfully execute joint safety activations.

- Proof-of-Resolve Crisis responders who show courage during emergencies.
- Proof-of-Memory Citizens who mint a personal safety moment into the civic legacy chain.

Each NFT carries metadata—time, place, participants—turning safety into story and ensuring vigilance is not forgotten.

11.1.5 Treasury & Progression Mechanics

The PoX³ structure powers a regenerative funding cycle for safety. Every Proof minted adds to the treasury, sustaining campaigns while rewarding participation.

- Allocation: A fixed percentage of each PoX₁ transaction flows into local, state, national, and global safety treasuries.
- Progression: PoX₂ badges can evolve into higher-tier legacy tokens with repeat participation.
- Recognition: PoX₃ honors remain soulbound, ensuring excellence cannot be bought—only earned.

Application: The treasury finances Smart Safe Zones, Recovery Hubs, Volunteer Platforms, and Drill Weeks, with transparency ensured by blockchain-backed allocation.

Conclusion — Vigilance as Legacy

The PoX³ Network-of-Proof is not only a technical system—it is a cultural foundation for public safety. It ensures that every meal purchased, every drill attended, every crisis responded to is remembered as proof of care. In this way, funding becomes transparent, recognition becomes eternal, and vigilance becomes a living archive of resilience.

Per Diem does not just build safe spaces—it builds a memory system where presence itself is proof of belonging, protection, and legacy.

11.2 Treasury Matrix - A Living Treasury That Shelters Lives

The Per Diem Treasury Matrix is not a vault but a breathing ledger—a constellation of token reserves built across verticals like \$LODGE, \$DINING and \$PARK. In normal times, these pools fund experiences, upgrades and creative quests. In emergencies, the matrix becomes a lifeline: liquidity bridges and cross-vertical staking allow value to flow instantly from hospitality and entertainment into temporary shelter, food and recovery.

The treasury has four economic layers—Guest, Partner, Governance and Performance—each of which can be activated for housing. Guest funds normally allocated for perks can redirect to Shelter Pass NFTs. Partner funds, usually reserved for vendors and artists, can subsidize vacant rooms. Governance treasuries vote on emergency disbursements. Performance reserves, which honor excellence, can mint PoX³ tokens for volunteers and responders who support evacuees. The matrix thus breathes with the network, turning presence into sanctuary.

Functional Mechanics

- Interconnected reserves: Each vertical has its own treasury, but all are bridged by the \$PERDIEM token. This allows a seamless transfer of value—turning unspent dining tokens into housing vouchers at a moment's notice.
- Cross-vertical staking: Holding multiple tokens together yields compound rewards; during crises, those staking bundles can earn emergency-housing badges or accelerated redemption rights.
- DAO-wide quests and lore campaigns: Multi-token quests draw proportionally from each vault, enabling "Shelter Runs"—special events where attendees donate tokens across verticals to fund relief shelters.

 Performance recognition: The Performance layer funds soulbound PoX³ tokens—Proof of Excellence—rewarding stewards of patience and care. These tokens elevate responders and volunteers into legends of the memory chain, ensuring their work is never forgotten.

11.2.1 Emergency Housing Through the Matrix

When disaster strikes, the Treasury Matrix can be mobilized in seconds. Smart contracts reroute transaction fees from \$DINING, \$SPA or \$CLUB to an emergency housing reserve. Via liquidity pools, tokens like \$GRUB or \$TRAVEL can be exchanged for \$LODGE in real time, funding Shelter Pass NFTs for evacuees. Guests redeeming experiences during crisis periods receive PoX² NFTs—a record of generosity that evolves over time. Governance votes can extend redemption windows or approve cross-vertical subsidies, while performance funds mint PoX³ tokens for support teams and responders.

Housing Activation Details

 Shelter Pass Funding: Guest-layer funds and cross-vertical liquidity pools convert tokens to \$LODGE, minting time-sensitive Shelter Pass NFTs that provide emergency lodging.

- Rapid Resource Reallocation: DAO governance can trigger a "Treasury Pulse," reallocating a percentage of partner and governance layers to the emergency housing vault within minutes.
- Staking Incentives: Token holders who stake across verticals unlock emergency-housing rewards—such as priority access to safe rooms or the ability to gift shelter passes to others.
- Proof-of-Presence & Excellence: PoX² badges
 commemorate donors and volunteers; PoX³ honors staff
 and first responders who go above and beyond, ensuring
 their service is engraved in the network's memory.

11.2.2 Public Safety & Civic Duty

Integrating the Token Spectrum – A Unified Matrix of Presence, Hospitality & Safety

The Community Stewardship Sector and the broader
Tokenomics Matrix are meant to be more than ledgers; they are
living maps of intention. By weaving together tokens from Per
Diem's Master Plan, Stadium Plan and Public Safety Plan,
turning every plan into a cohesive story of value, presence and
care. Each vertical token functions as its own micro-economy,
yet they remain interconnected through the **\$PERDIEM**

protocol token. This integration allows the network to flex fluidly—from spa treatments and concerts to safety drills and community gardens—while recording contributions through the **PoX³: Network-of-Proof**. In emergencies, the matrix channels resources swiftly; in moments of celebration, it rewards participation; in daily life, it honours service with soulbound memory tokens.

By cataloguing all existing tokens and proposing strategic additions, we ensure that the Public Safety Plan and its civic counterparts are fully supported. Master Plan and Stadium Plan tokens anchor the core experiences: hospitality, travel, dining, entertainment and wellness. Public Safety Plan tokens prioritise preparedness, wellness and community resilience. Proposed tokens expand the safety net to cover housing, mental health, food security and civic engagement—creating new micro-economies that encourage neighbours to look after each other. This matrix is not a static vault; it is a breathing network of trust and reciprocity.

11.2.3 Master Plan & Stadium Plan Tokens

\$PERDIEM – Protocol Token: Governs cross-vertical governance and bridges all vertical treasuries.

\$TRAVEL – Token of Movement & Wayfinding: Powers transportation and tier unlocks; mints maps when journeys connect experiences.

\$LODGE – Token of Stillness & Retreat: Redeemed for overnight stays, meditations and wellness quests.

\$\$PA – Token of Presence & Purification: Unlocks time-based rituals like hydrotherapy and yoga.

\$DINING – Token of Culinary Legacy: Fuels prix-fixe menus and curated gastronomic adventures.

\$GRUB – Token of Craving & Collective Appetite: Supports quick-serve, delivery, street food, food trucks and flavour quests.

\$CLUB – Token of Expression & Rhythm: Grants access to DJs, dance floors and immersive parties.

\$PARK – Token of Adventure & Discovery: Used for rides, trails and scavenger quests.

\$EVENT – Token of Assembly & Awe: Fuels concerts, theatre and large gatherings.

\$MERCH – Token of Wearable Memory: Ties physical merchandise to lore and guest journeys.

\$GAME – Token of Play & Competition: Unlocks gaming arenas, e-sports tournaments and interactive competitions; mints collectibles when players achieve milestones and connect communities through play.

11.2.4 Public Safety Plan Tokens

\$SAFE, \$GUARD, \$WATCH – Preparedness & Protection: Funds drills, training and neighbourhood watch initiatives while honouring excellence in protection.

\$CARE, \$HEAL, \$MIND — Wellness & Healing: Supports mental-health services, holistic healing and crisis recovery.

\$HOME, \$SHELTER, \$TEMP – Shelter & Housing: Provides housing subsidies, transitional lodging and emergency shelter.

\$RELOC, \$MEAL – Relief & Relocation: Covers relocation costs and supplies nutritious meals during crises.

\$CLINIC, \$HEALTH – Medical & Clinical: Delivers medical care, therapy and community health outreach.

\$BUILD, \$FURNISH, \$UTILITY – Rebuild & Utilities: Funds rebuilding, furnishing homes and maintaining essential services.

\$EDU, \$EDUCARE, \$MENTOR – Education & Mentorship: Recognises tutoring, childcare support and youth mentorship programmes.

\$CIVIC, \$SERVE, \$VOICE – Civic Service & Advocacy: Rewards civic engagement, volunteerism and advocacy efforts.

\$UNITY, \$FUND – Unity & Philanthropy: Encourages community cohesion and matched fundraising for relief.

\$GREEN, \$EARTH, \$GARDEN – Environmental Stewardship: Champions environmental work, planetary stewardship and urban agriculture.

\$PARKS, \$SHARE, \$PAWS – Parks & Sharing: Supports park maintenance, resource sharing and animal welfare initiatives.

\$ARTS, \$MUSIC, \$HERITAGE - Arts & Heritage: Cultivates arts, music and cultural heritage programmes.

\$TECH, \$COMMUTE – Technology & Transport: Provides digital access and transportation assistance.

Collectively, these tokens—both foundational and new—create a mosaic of care. Each group turns everyday actions into micro-economies that fund shelter, food, healing, education, culture and environmental stewardship. By bringing all tokens into view and grouping them thoughtfully, we ensure the matrix remains a flexible, purpose-driven system capable of uplifting every corner of the Per Diem universe—from the stadium lights to the neighbourhood streets.

11.2.5 Recommendations & Additional Suggestions

- 1. Automatic Overflow Mechanism: Set threshold levels for each vertical; when a vault surpasses its target, surplus automatically flows into the emergency housing fund.
- 2. Cross-Vertical Charity Quests: Organize ongoing quests where guests earn PoX badges for donating or staking tokens toward emergency housing, with tiered rewards (e.g., gold badges for recurring support).
- 3. Real-Time Transparency: Public dashboards should display fund levels, incoming flows, and housing disbursements in real time. This builds trust and encourages participation.
- 4. Community Governance & Rapid Voting: Empower local sub-DAO governors to initiate emergency allocations without waiting for broader quorum, enabling faster relief.
- 5. Flexible Redemption Windows: Extend PoX redemptions for affected guests; allow conversion of entertainment credits into food, shelter, or mental-health services during recovery periods.
- 6. Cross-Sector Partnerships: Collaborate with city shelters, nonprofits and health providers to accept \$LODGE and \$SHELTER tokens, expanding the network's reach and impact.
- 7. Narrative Integration: Use PoX² storytelling campaigns to humanize emergency responses—transforming financial

aid into collective memory and inspiring wider involvement.

Closing Reflection

The Per Diem Treasury Matrix is more than a ledger—it is a tapestry of care and possibility. By weaving together vertical treasuries through \$PERDIEM and animating them with the PoX³ network, the system becomes a safety net that can catch those who fall. In emergencies, tokens move with purpose; memories are minted into courage; and the act of sheltering another becomes a collective memory. The treasury doesn't just allocate funds; it tells stories of generosity, courage and community. In this way, Per Diem proves that a financial system can hold not only wealth, but humanity and hope.

11.3 Tokenomics Structure for Housing Emergencies

11.3.1 A Treasury That Shelters Stories

In Per Diem's ecosystem, value is not measured by numbers alone—it is measured by acts of care, presence and resilience. The token treasury channels these values into a fund that can be mobilized for housing emergencies. Every transaction—buying a meal, booking a seat, tipping a barista—generates a micro-contribution into a community safety pool via

Proof-of-Exchange (PoX₁). This continuous stream forms the financial backbone of an emergency housing fund.

When disaster strikes—a family evicted, a survivor fleeing violence, a wildfire displacing a town—the treasury unlocks resources in seconds. NFT-encoded Shelter Passes—unique, geo-time sensitive tokens—are issued to those in need. Smart contracts release \$LODGE, \$SAFE, or \$CARE tokens to lodging and care partners only after verified check-ins, check-ups, and check-outs, ensuring that aid is efficient and transparent. In this model, emergency shelter is not a charity; it is a community contract underwritten by everyday participation.

- Shelter Pass NFTs hold metadata: eligible shelter type, location radius, expiry window. They are scanned at check-in, creating an immutable record and releasing funds upon check-out.
- PoX₁ Contributions: Each transaction across Per Diem's verticals allocates a fraction to the emergency housing pool.
- Real-Time Governance: DAO dashboards track redemption rates and fund levels, allowing the community to allocate tokens where crises erupt.
- Cultural Memory: PoX² badges immortalize every act of giving—donors and volunteers receive proof-of-presence

NFTs or badges and \$CARE tokens that honour their compassion.

11.3.2 Transitional Housing: Earning Stability Through Presence

After crisis relief, Per Diem's token system supports a work-to-stay transitional program. Individuals moving from shelters or treatment facilities earn tokens by contributing to the community—completing job training, mentoring, volunteering or counselling sessions. These tokens pay for rent in modular co-living units and essential services (food, transit, data). Proof-of-Experience (PoX₂) badges mark each milestone—"90 Days Clean," "Employed," "Mentor"—and unlock increased benefits. A decentralized task board allows nonprofits to post opportunities, turning social impact into a tokenized gig economy.

- Earned Tokens: Residents gain \$LODGE or \$CIVIC tokens for verified service hours or educational achievements; smart contracts release tokens automatically after proof of completion.
- Badging & Levelling: NFT badges track milestones and serve as utility triggers—higher tiers grant rent discounts, mental health stipends or bonus tokens.

- Peer Verification: Residents vouch for each other; verified endorsements yield extra rewards.
- Use Cases: Tokens pay for housing, groceries, transit passes and digital connectivity, converting personal growth into economic currency and reducing relapse into homelessness.

11.3.3 Recommendations & Enhancements

- 1. Create dedicated tokens such as \$SHELTER for emergency lodging and \$REBUILD for post-crisis reintegration. These could be funded by a percentage of all \$LODGE transactions and matched by philanthropic donors.
- Introduce micro-insurance pools within the treasury.
 Community members can stake tokens into an insurance pool that pays out in the event of sudden displacement, earning a modest APY when not in use.
- 3. Emergency Housing DAO: A specialized DAO comprised of social workers, survivors, donors and token holders could oversee deployment of shelter funds, ensure fairness and vote on the creation of new relief programs.
- 4. Hybrid PoX/NFT Fundraisers: During festivals or concerts, sell limited-edition NFT art with proceeds earmarked for

- the housing treasury. These tokens could unlock backstage tours, community dinners or artistic collaborations.
- 5. Integrated Wellness Credits: Combine \$CARE tokens with transitional housing to provide mental health care and counseling, reinforcing that recovery and housing are intertwined.
- 6. Real-Time Transparency Dashboards: Visualize treasury flows—how many tokens are in the shelter fund, where they were spent, how many nights of shelter were provided. This builds trust and invites continual participation.

Conclusion: From Currency to Care

By intertwining the Per Diem Treasury with the PoX³
Network-of-Proof, shelter becomes a community project rather than an isolated expense. Every cup of coffee, every concert ticket, every ride on a cable car contributes to a reservoir of safety. PoX₁ records how funds flow, PoX₂ turns experiences into memorials of compassion and growth, and PoX₃ elevates the quiet heroes—volunteers, shelter staff, social workers, first responders—into legends. In moments of crisis, this system springs into action, delivering emergency housing with dignity and speed. In the days after, it offers pathways to stability and

ownership. With these mechanics, Per Diem proves that presence can build homes, that memory can create security, and that currency can carry care.

12 Exit & Continuity Strategy – Realising Value and Legacy

No plan is complete without a vision for how participants, contributors and investors conclude their journey. In the Per Diem Public Safety Plan, "exit" is not abandonment but realisation—a moment when value is returned, impact is measured and legacy is secured. Because the Treasury Matrix is modular and governed by smart contracts, exit pathways are predictable, transparent and equitable. The Guest, Partner, Governance and Performance layers of the matrix ensure that funds are earmarked for specific purposes; when a vertical completes its mission or an investor's term ends, tokens can be unstaked, redeemed or swapped across the network. DAO proposals set vesting schedules and buyback mechanisms, allowing investors to convert their \$PERDIEM stakes or vertical tokens back into stable assets or reallocate them into new community projects.

For mission-driven participants, exit is expressed through **Legacy Dividends**: PoX³ soulbound recognitions and

commemorative NFTs that archive contributions and confirm that value flowed to communities. Profits generated by hospitality, entertainment or safety initiatives can be distributed pro rata to token holders who elect to retire their positions. Impact investors may choose an **impact rollover**, redirecting returns to the Environmental Stewardship or Unity & Philanthropy pools, converting financial exit into social reinvestment. The network's liquidity bridges allow tokens like \$LODGE, \$DINING, or \$SAFE to be exchanged for others, ensuring that no capital is trapped and that investors can tailor their exit based on personal values and market conditions. Ultimately, the exit strategy honours both **financial prudence and poetic permanence**: it lets capital move on while memorialising every act of care in the chain of memory.
