CLASS PROJECT

Create a class artwork inspired by Tom Thomson's *Wildflowers* using only recycled or repurposed materials. Upcycling encourages students to reduce waste and think creatively. Your piece may include painting, collage, sculpture, drawing, or mixed media.

ART SUBMISSION RULES & GUIDELINES

- Use only the provided class canvas as your artwork base.
- Materials must be fully recycled, reused, or single-use plastics (e.g., Bottle caps, cardboard pieces, egg cartons, popsicle sticks, yarn scraps, fabric/denim scraps, buttons, plastic lids, and magazine or coloured paper scraps).
- No new materials may be purchased—collect items from home, school, or outdoors.
- Please follow standard safety precautions when collecting materials (wash items and wash hands after handling).
- A completed Class Submission Form must accompany the artwork.
- Deadline: Artwork must be finished and ready for pickup on Friday March 6, 2026.
- Finished artworks will be displayed at the Tom Thomson Art Gallery (April 1–30, 2026) and in River District storefronts (May 1–31, 2026), with a special family night event on Tuesday April 28, 2026 from 5-7pm.
