This year, families are being charged the cost of each costume instead of a general blanket fee, which is why the amounts may vary between classes. Our goal is to keep costs as fair and transparent as possible for everyone.

Flash Dance Company is excited to introduce our **Costume Buy Back Program!** Dancers will have the opportunity to return gently used costumes in exchange for account credit (\$10 per costume). These costumes will become part of our growing studio collection, allowing us to offer costume rentals for future performances. This initiative helps keep costs down for our families while promoting sustainability and creativity within our studio.

We are also actively working to purchase additional costumes to expand our inventory, making it even easier to provide high-quality, affordable options for all dancers. ♡

Costume Distribution

Costume distribution will take place during regular class time once costumes arrive. Each dancer will have the opportunity to try on their costume in class to ensure the best fit. If any adjustments are needed, we will work quickly to exchange for the correct size.

Please note that costumes will only be sent home once all costume fees have been paid in full. This helps us stay organized and ensures a smooth distribution process for all families.

Costumes will be sent home in a labeled box with your dancer's name on it. This box should be used to transport costumes to and from the recital, as it helps keep everything organized and protected. Each costume will also include a card with the dance name and all necessary details for that costume.

All costume boxes must be returned to Flash Dance Company by the end of May.

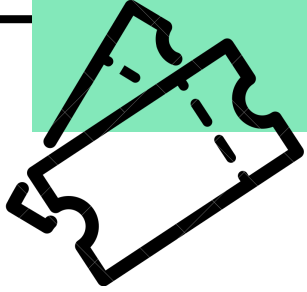

This includes expenses such as venue rental, stage setup, lighting and sound equipment, event staffing, and production coordination. It also helps support administrative planning, rehearsal time, and overall event organization to ensure everything runs smoothly. Our goal is to provide a memorable recital that allows every dancer to shine on stage while creating a special and seamless experience for everyone involved.

This also includes 2 tickets to each recital your child is in.

Tickets at the door are \$10/seat

When do tickets go on sale?

Saturday April 18th 10am - 12pm

April 19 - May 7th (Monday - Thursday 3pm - 7pm)

How do I purchase tickets?

Visit the studio to reserve your seats & purchase your tickets.

How do I get my tickets that are included in my Recital Fee?

Once your recital fee is paid, you can visit the studio to reserve your seats. Tickets must be picked up from the studio May 7th as they will **not** be available at the door at no cost.

Do dancers need tickets?

No. Dancers do not need a ticket for the show they are performing in. If they would like to attend the other show, they will not need a ticket. They can sit in empty seats or on the side.

Are tickets refundable or transferable?

Tickets are non-refundable. However, they may be transferred to another family if needed.

What if I lose my ticket?

Stop by the ticket desk at the venue & give them your dancers first & last name. They will pull up your ticket.

Can I buy a ticket at the door?

Yes, you can purchase tickets at the door for \$10 each. You will choose from the seats left that were not reserved during presale.

Do I have to wear my costume?

Yes, Recital 2 rehearsal will be a dress rehearsal. Please arrive in (or change into) your first dance costume (based on the order provided with your costume box) & bring your box that contains your other costumes, shoes, and others items needed. You are welcome to leave this overnight.

Make sure to label all shoes.

Where do I go when I get to the Fine Arts Center?

Please arrive **in the front lobby** and check in with our staff. A modesty/nude leotard is recommended if changing costumes multiple times. Dancers, please take the first 15 minutes to prepare your quick changes with your teachers, warm-up, and be ready in costume for the full dress rehearsal run through. Hair and makeup does NOT need to be done for rehearsal.

Dismissal:

Once rehearsal is finished, you will check your child out in the lobby. If they are in both recitals, they can stay with us backstage.

All staff and volunteers must attend rehearsal. Please speak with Ms. Dallas if you are interested in volunteering.

How do I layer my tights for different dances?

BASE LAYER

*Put on first.
MODESTY/NUDE LEOTARD

NEXT

The color of tights you need to perform in LAST.

LAST

The color of tights you need to perform in FIRST.

Performance Day

Packing Checklist

All costumes, shoes, tights, accessories & any additional items should be stored and brought to the recital in your recital/costume box. No bags will be allowed backstage.

Modesty/Nude Leotard
Worn under all costumes as a base layer for those with multiple costume changes.

Dance Shoes
Labeled with dancer's name.

Water Bottle
Preferably with a screw top (no straws in case it's tipped over).
Clear liquids ONLY backstage.

Hair Accessories
Bobby pins, hairspray, ponytail holders., etc

Extra shoes
Dancers should leave the auditorium in street shoes, not dance shoes.

All Tights
Pink, Tan or both depending on classes.

Recital/Costume Box
Wear your first costume. All others in your recital box.

Make-up
Dancers should arrive with make-up done, but may have supplies for touch ups if needed.

DO NOT BRING

- Food that is messy and could get on a costume.
- More items than you need - space in the dressing rooms is tight.
- Expensive jewelry or electronics that you do not want lost or broken.
- Dance Bags - Everything should go in your recital/costume box.

Recital Day

We are so excited for recital day! To help everything run smoothly and ensure a great experience for our dancers and families, please review the information below.

What time is the recital?

- **Recital 1:** Recital 1 starts at 4:00pm and should last around an hour and 15 minutes.
- **Recital 2:** Recital 2 starts at 6:00pm and should last around an hour and a half.

What time should we arrive?

- **Recital 1:** Auditorium Doors will open at 3:00pm. Dancers will check in at 3:30pm.
- **Recital 2:** Dancers will check in at 5:30pm.

Where do dancers go when we arrive?

- Dancers should be brought to the designated check-in area to the right of the stage in the auditorium.
- Once checked in, dancers will remain backstage with staff for the duration of the recital. Parents will not be allowed backstage.

How should my dancer arrive?

- Dancers should arrive in their first costume with hair and makeup fully done. This helps us stay on schedule and reduces stress backstage.
- Please ensure that undergarments are neutral colors so they do not show on stage.

What should my dancer bring?

- All costumes, dance shoes and tights (in their labeled box)
- Hair accessories and makeup (if desired) (in their labeled box)
- Optional: Water bottle (labeled) - We will have snacks and drinks backstage for them

Reminder: Use the recital/costume box provided to keep everything organized.

Will staff be available by phone?

- Staff will have limited access to their phones on recital day. You may not receive an immediate response to calls or messages.
- If you need assistance, please speak with a staff member at check-in or the front area.

Do I need a ticket?

- Yes, all audience members must have a ticket for entry.
- Each recital is a different ticket.
- Tickets can be purchased during pre-sale or at the door. Tickets at the door are cash, cashapp, or venmo ONLY.

Can I take pictures or videos?

- Absolutely. Please be respectful for others around you and avoid flash photography

Recital Day

We are so excited for recital day! To help everything run smoothly and ensure a great experience for our dancers and families, please review the information below.

How can I help the day run smoothly?

- Arrive on time
- Label all items
- Follow staff instructions
- Be patient and positive—this is an exciting day for the dancers!

What if my dancer gets nervous?

- This is totally normal! We will do everything we can to give them the confidence they need.

Can I check out my dancer after their dance?

- No, all dancers must remain backstage through the entire recital. This is to ensure safety of our dancers, staff, and volunteers & to create a great experience for all involved.

What is the dismissal process?

- Once the recital is over, you will check out your dancer the same way you checked them in, but on the opposite side.
- Please have 1 person check them out at the check out table to the left of the stage using the pass you will be provided at check in.
- This is for the safety of our dancers, so we kindly ask that you please be patient with our staff and volunteers.

What if my dancer leaves something at the Fine Arts Center?

- Staff will collect anything left behind and bring it to the studio. You can contact us or swing by to obtain your item.

How do I return our recital costume box?

- Recital boxes should be returned to the studio by April 1st.

When is our next class?

- The week after recital will be a week of fun during your regularly scheduled class.
- We will celebrate a great season together.
- This will be our last class until the next season. Please be on the lookout for summer camp info.
