Details of the pre-application advice received
 The principle of development is acceptable on the basis of the site's location in the settlement boundary and the site allocation. The proposed density of development (i.e. 17 units) is acceptable and justified on the basis of the affordable nature of development and need for housing in the area. The Council suggested the inclusion of a pedestrian access point to the north-eastern corner of the site between Plots 15 and 16 to ensure site permeability and facilitate shorter walking times to other areas within the settlement. The Council encouraged the use of mixed external finishes to the dwellings to provide visual character and interest (stone / brick and render) to avoid a monotonous and boring streetscene. The Council suggested that Plots 8-9 and 14-15 be provided as bungalow so as to reduce the height of development to the corners of the site nearest the respective listed buildings resulting in Plots 10-13 being semi-detached units. A Reptile and Amphibian Method Statement and Mitigation Plan detailing mitigation measures and a precautionary working method statement will be required. A lighting plan for the site will be required.
