The Methods Studio proposal was agreed upon and approved by everyone present. It was also discussed to collaborate with the county to begin traffic studies and begin dialogue for helping traffic flow into and out of the park once fully completed.

It was discussed that we would consider the Historical Park and its significance and proximity to the 72-acre park. The City of Shelley would like to deed it over to the Recreational District. It is 20+ acres. Currently, IDEAS runs the Historical Park and takes care of the maintenance. No decision was made.

Croft Twilight Park has begun its construction. Lorin Croft and his wife Connie bought the lot and is putting a park on there and then giving it to the City of Shelley. The Rec District has agreed to give up to \$40K toward the building of the park. Concrete was supposed to be poured last Friday, but the weather did not permit them to.

Approval of bills for Karrie Winder was brought up. When the Rec District was getting on the ballot, Karrie put forth some money for stickers and billboard advertisement. The total was \$917.48. All in favor to pay back Karrie.

Adam brought up that because there is money sitting the bank, that some of it should be invested into CDs. The current rate is 4.8% but some other banks are around 5%. He will double check and see if ICCU will match the other offers. It was decided to put \$250,000 into a CD for 6 months. All Approved.

Adam presented a website that he is creating through Go Daddy. Mostly informational. He is waiting on head shots and a small blurb from everyone on the committee. It will cost roughly \$40 per year if maintained by him. He has agreed to do so.

Karrie brought up that the North End Mile event needs to be cancelled until next year. She feels we are not ready and the word is not going to get out in time. The committee agreed to postpone the event until next year.
