<u>BEFORE CLASSES BEGIN:</u> Parent should login to the Parent Portal on <u>www.myafterschoolprogram.com</u> to view your student's schedule. Do not send your student to a class they are waitlisted for. That class is FULL. We have specific capacities and procedures. THIS IS ALSO A GOOD TIME TO ADD PICK UP PERSONS FOR YOUR STUDENT IN THE STUDENT PROFILE IN YOUR PARENT PORTAL ACCOUNT. PICK UP PERSONS MUST BE LISTED IN STUDENT PROFILE AS A PARENT OR EMERGENCY CONTACT FOR THE INSTRUCTOR TO RELEASE THE STUDENT.

PLEASE SHARE THESE PROGRAM DETAILS, EXPECTATIONS, and PROCEDURES BELOW WITH YOUR STUDENT TO HELP PREPARE THEM FOR NEXT WEEK.

<u>PARENT MUST CHANGE END OF SCHOOL DAY DISMISSAL PROCEDURE:</u> For all extras enrolled students (INCLUDING Full-time VHAS AFTERCARE STUDENTS) use this link from VHES that provides instructions on how to change your student's end of school day dismissal to VHAS Extras:

If this dismissal change is not done, the student will be dismissed via their usual daily procedure in Pik My Kid. This is for the END OF SCHOOL DAY DISMISSAL.

- If your student has special needs not mentioned in your student's registration, email
 <u>beth@myafterschoolprogram.com</u> to make sure your student's experience, the experience of the other students
 and their instructors is the best that it can be. These notifications assist the instructors as they prepare lessons for
 each class. This includes any in class behavior plans that we can continue in the afternoons, any new sensory issues,
 allergies, fears, etc.
- Start time for first hour classes will show 2:15 on the schedule. Please note that from 2:15/school dismissal, Extras students are in transition from their school day to their instructors in the cafeteria. Instructors will report absences to Ms. Monica and parents of absent students will be called.
- Instructors and students will transition to their class space at 2:30-2:35. Students are released directly to extracurriculars check-in cafeteria at the end of their school day via end of school announcements.
- Snacks will not be eaten during the extracurricular program afternoon. Students returning to aftercare after their extracurricular will be provided their afternoon snack after their extracurricular class has met. If you have concerns about your student being hungry, the student's school day classroom teacher may let them have their brought from home snack before end of school day dismissal.
- All classes take place at the Virginia-Highland Elementary campus.
- ABSENCE NOTIFICATIONS: If your student will be absent, parent should text Monica at 678-891-9220 by 1:30 on the day they will miss their class. Be sure to include student name, class they will miss, and school they attend (we have 6!). Parents can also email the same absence information to beth@myafterschoolprogram.com and monica@myafterschoolprogram.com by noon the day the class meets. Please do not text us absences two weeks in advance. You don't have to text and email, but please do one or the other! It is our policy to call parents each day a student.

does not arrive for their class if we have not been notified or the student is not on the school absence report.

Parents, please know, elementary school classroom teachers do not relay your student's school day absences or early pickups to us. Being mindful of your student's absence notifications to MASP/VHAS Extras helps us be efficient!

- <u>STUDENT PICKUP/DISMISSAL:</u> Please arrive no more than 10 minutes early for pick up. Dismissal times are staggered-some classes dismiss at 3:30, 3:45 or later- check your student's schedule in their personal profile in your Parent Portal account for their class end time.
- ALL Full-Time VHAS after care students (and drop ins attending VHAS on the day they have an extras class) will be
 dismissed from their extracurricular program back to VHAS aftercare; VHAS Full Time aftercare parents (or VHAS
 drop ins attending that day after class) should be picked up in the VHAS aftercare dismissal area.
- Person picking up should be prepared to show ID. This is for the safety of your student. IN THE STUDENT PROFILE (not in the parent profile!), make sure your nannies, grandparents, spouses, siblings that may pick up your student are added to your www.myafterschoolprogram.com Parent Portal account as an EMERGENCY CONTACT. Otherwise, they will be asked to step aside the pick-up line, we will call you and see if they are permitted to pick up. We will not release a student without permissions from the parent/guardian the student's portal account. We do not have access to student pick-up persons within the APS system; we are an independent business and have our own system.
- Our dismissal procedure: Park in a designated parking space in the front parking lot and walk up to the front of the school. Dismissal will take place at the school entrance doors. Parents will remain outside; please line up behind the cone with your student's class name on it. Instructors will stand at a door near your dismissal cone, they will ask you to walk up, then they will check your ID and then release your student. Students will be held inside until ID is verified as an EMERGENCY CONTACT/PICK UP PERSON.
- WE ARE A NO CELL PHONE ZONE SO THAT PARENTS/CAREGIVERS ARE AWARE OF ANY INSTRUCTIONS AS THEY ARRIVE!
- If <u>in an emergency situation</u>, someone other than the parent or additional contacts you entered in our system will pick your student up after an extracurricular class, **PARENT must notify Beth via text at 770-605-5456 and Monica at 678-891-9220** by 3:15 the day the class meets and additionally, <u>IF the pickup person will pick up on a regular basis</u>, <u>ADD THE PICK UP PERSON TO YOUR STUDENT'S PROFILE in www.myafterschoolprogram.com</u>.
- VHAS aftercare students will transition back into the VHAS aftercare program when their extracurricular class ends and dismissed using the aftercare release process.
- The first two weeks of class, there will likely be delays during release as the instructors and students get used to these new procedures. We appreciate your patience during this time!!
- The safety of each student is our primary concern. Please let one of us know of any joys your student has shared about their class or let us know about any concerns that you may have regarding extracurricular programs.
- Feedback (positive or negative) will allow us to improve and/or add programming to better serve the students at Virginia- Highland After School Extras (VHAS EXTRAS). It is our mission to provide safe, quality, fun and engaging programming to our students.

- Class changes will be made until Friday, September 17 at 7PM. After that, no changes will be made.
- If a school system shut-down occurs at any time during this semester, we will place the programs on HOLD and resume once we return. If for some reason a class does not come back in person, you will be

REMINDERS: All students enrolled in second hour classes (IN RED) must either transition from a first hour class if enrolled, the VHAS aftercare program if enrolled OR be brought back to the school by a parent or caregiver at the start of class. No students are allowed on campus unattended in the hour between school dismissal and their extracurricular class starting. PARENT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR, PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF THE SECOND HOUR CLASS, MAKING SURE THEIR STUDENT HAS CARE DURING THE HOUR BETWEEN SCHOOL DISMISSAL AND A your parent portal account on myafterschoolprogram.com.

FOR THIS SCHOOL YEAR: IF a first hour student in grades 3-5 will be released from their EXTRACURRICULAR to walk home after their class OR if a second hour student will walk back to the school to their extracurricular, you must notify beth@myafterschoolprogram.com By SUNDAY 9/7. (NOTE: Second hour students walking back FOR ANY MASP EXTRAS CLASS MUST arrive 5 minutes before class start time. IF they cannot be at the school by that time, parent or caregiver will be required to bring them back to the school. We take attendance and must account for each child at the class start time. STUDENTS ENROLLED IN MASP AFTERCARE FULL TIME OR ATTENDING AS A DROP IN ON THE DAY A class meets are not permitted to be walkers.
