No previous experience with robotics is necessary. Returning students will be given the freedom to build upon past experiences on new platforms and challenges. Activities focus on honing critical thinking skills, perseverance and teamwork as students learn to program, use sensors and design attachments. For the spring 2024, we will explore the world of Battle Bots and compete in our own TRI ROBOTICS SUMO CUP! Teams of students will compete to out program, out design and out build their peers. There will be a friendly competition between Sarah Smith Elementary, Warren T. Jackson and Springdale Park Elementary at the end of the term. Using the LEGO MINDSTORM EV3 and RC battle bot platforms, students will learn programming and building skills that will translate nicely to the FLL competition we compete in each Fall. For those not necessarily interested in competing in the SUMO challenge, there will be options to build a host of helper bots as well as the robotic arena itself. 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Drones and Design with Steam Powered Kids	Mondays	01/22/2024	04/22/2024	4:00 PM 5:00 PM	\$434	4	5	<p>Drones and Design Spring 2024 (Elementary) 4-5th grades, prior robotics experience with Steam Powered Kids required. The program prepares members to fly and build drones to participate in the yearly Drones For Good (DFG) Competition hosted by the Midtown High School drones team. You can learn more about competition here: <a href="https://g3dfg.org/Students">https://g3dfg.org/Students</a> will work both individually and in teams to develop winning designs. The competition itself will be held in the 2024 spring term on April 27. Previous experience with drones is required. In addition to the built-from-scratch drones we work on for team competition, students will be responsible for the upkeep and health of their trainer drone that they will use to practice obstacles, learn battery management and hone their piloting skills. When not flying, we will delve into the world of material science as we encourage experimenting with different materials to achieve the delicate balance between strength and weight. Drone safety is our number-one priority and by the end of the term all students will have completed drone safety and certification with the FAA and AMA (Academy of Model Aeronautics). This includes passing the Recreational UAS Safety Test (TRUST) that allows for the flying of drones over .5 lbs. A youth membership of \$15/year with the AMA is required to participate in the DFG competition and is not included in the registration cost of this program. All supplies are included in the Fee, including the trainer drones.
