Conditions:

By signing this Eligibility and Participation Form, Student and Student's Parent/Guardian represent to the Medford School District that:

1. Student is fully covered by the indicated insurance program.
2. Student has a current athletic physical form administered and signed by an Oregon licensed medical examiner on file with the school's administration.
3. Student and Parent/Guardian have read the Participation Standards, Problem Solving and Extracurricular Code of Conduct and acknowledge the academic, behavioral and residence requirements related to eligibility for North Medford and/or South Medford High Schools and understand the rules, regulations and expectations for both students, staff, parents, and fans as described in the student handbook and/or distributed materials.

By signing this Eligibility and Participation Form, Student and Student's Parent/Guardian acknowledge and agree to the following terms and conditions, each of which is a requirement of participating in Community Club Sports:

4. Student must meet Medford School District academic requirements, as well as any academic requirements that may be imposed by the club team. By the first day of school recorded on the Student transcript, a 10th grader must have earned at least 4.5 credits, an 11th grader at least 10 credits, and a 12th grader at least 17 credits. At a minimum, Student must have at least 2.5 credits in the previous semester grading period, which is equivalent to passing ten .25 credit classes. In addition, at the time of the activity, the Student must be enrolled and in good standing in at least 5 classes.
 - a. Students who enroll in authorized Medford School District on-line courses are responsible to notify the Athletic Office by showing a hard copy of proof of enrollment and grades at the beginning/end of each quarter. This includes on-line college credits/classes, independent PE and work-experience.
 - b. In addition to the academic requirements described above, the Medford School District requires that students involved in extra-curricular activities who earn one or more "F" grades in each of the previous two quarters become ineligible to compete. Students may become eligible on a week-to-week basis after being placed on, and meeting the requirements of, a weekly Plan of Assistance to be administered by the Athletic Director. The Athletic Director will determine the point at which the Student may or may not participate in activities.
 - c. Student, if Student is 18 years of age or older, and Parent/Guardian, if Student is younger than 18, expressly grant consent to Medford School District to disclose Student's education records, including but not limited to Student's grades and disciplinary information, to Student's coach or other person responsible for ensuring that participants on the Community Club Sports team are academically eligible and otherwise in good standing with the school.
5. Student and/or Parent/Guardian will be held financially responsible for the return or and any damage to any equipment owned by Medford School District and issued to Student as part of Student's participation in Community Club Sports.
6. **Parent and Student/Guardian acknowledge and agree that the Medford School District is not a sponsor of the Community Club Sport or an insurer of Student's participation in the Community Club Sport, and that Medford School District assumes no financial or other obligation or responsibility for funding the Community Club Sport, including but not limited to providing any transportation, equipment or facilities for students participating in the Community Club Sport, or for any injury that may occur to Student or others as a result of participating in the Community Club Sport.**
7. **ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISKS:** Participation in Community Club Sports carries an inherent risk of injury, including but not limited to serious bodily injury such as sprains, fractures, ligament/cartilage damage, temporary or permanent physical impairment, brain damage, paralysis, or even death. Student and Parent/Guardian hereby acknowledge and understand the risks involved in participating in Community Club Sports, whether in competition, practice or in traveling to practice and/or events, and in the event Student and/or Parent/Guardian desire further information regarding specific risks that may be encountered as a result of participating in Student's chosen Community Club Sport, Student and/or Parent/Guardian will personally contact the coach prior to execution of this Eligibility and Participation Form. With full knowledge and understanding of the risk of serious injury to which Student may be exposed by participating in the Community Club Sport, Student and Parent/Guardian knowingly accept such risks, and voluntarily choose to allow Student to participate in the Community Club Sport.
8. **WAIVER AND RELEASE OF CLAIMS:** To the maximum extent permitted by law, Student and Parent/Guardian, for themselves and for their heirs, successors, and assigns, hereby release, waive, covenant not to sue and hold Medford School District, its directors, employee and agents, free and harmless from any and all liability, claims (including but not limited to attorneys' fees), demands, actions and causes of action whatsoever arising out of related to any loss, damage or injury, whether to person or to property, including but not limited to death, that may arise as a result of Student's participation in the Community Club Sport.
9. Student and Parent/Guardian authorize emergency medical treatment and/or transportation to a medical facility for any injury or illness to Student deemed urgently necessary by a coach, licensed trainer, or medical practitioner.
10. **It is the responsibility of Student and/or Parent/Guardian to immediately notify the Athletic Office at Student's school of representation for Community Club Sports, in writing, of any changes in the above information.**
11. I acknowledge and agree that the terms and conditions of this Eligibility and Participation Form, including but not limited to the Acknowledgment of Risks and the Waiver and Release set forth above, are intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the State of Oregon and that if any portion is held to be invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full force and effect.
