## Literary Scholarship

### Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be a current high school senior in any of the Decatur, Illinois High Schools (EHS, MHS, Unity Christian, ST.T)
- Have been accepted to a university or community college
- Plan to attend school in the Fall 2026 term
- Submit original written work
- Not be an immediate family member of the scholarship founder

### Award

- \$500 scholarship
- Funds will be paid directly to the recipient's university or community college in August 2026 and applied toward tuition or eligible educational fees.

### Required Submission Materials

Applicants must submit all of the following via email and include your name & email on document

#### 1. Choose one:

- Poem
- Short personal essay
- Creative reflection or narrative

Guidelines:

- 1–2 pages maximum (or up to ~750 words)
- Any theme or style
- Original work only

#### 2. A short written response to the prompt (up to ~750 words):

What does writing give you that the world sometimes cannot?

#### 3. Proof of Acceptance

- Screenshot or PDF of acceptance letter or email
- Applicant name and school name visible
- Personal details may be blurred if desired

### Submission Instructions

- Attach submissions as PDF

### Submission Limit

- Submissions are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis
- Applications will close once 50 complete submissions have been received

### Timeline

- Submissions open: February 1, 2026
- Submissions close: April 1, 2026 or once 50 submissions are received
- Recipient announced: May 2026
- Scholarship funds distributed to the school: August 2026

### Selection Process

Applications are reviewed holistically and selected based on:

- Authentic voice
- Emotional honesty
- Thoughtfulness of reflection
  - GPA, test scores, and recommendation letters are not considered.

### Privacy & Permissions

- All submissions are kept confidential and used solely for scholarship review.
- Public sharing of the recipient's name or work will occur only with written permission.
