"But the word of the Lord was unto them precept upon precept, line upon line, line upon line: here a little there a little, that they might go, and fall (H₃₇82) backward and be broken (H₇665) and snared (H₃₃69) and taken" (H₃₉₂₀) (Isaiah 28:13) AAA & ΩΩΩ

"Every man that eateth the sour grape, his teeth shall be set on edge" (Jeremiah 31:30b)

In the book of Job, Eliphaz says:

"let not him that is deceived trust in vanity, for vanity shall be his recompse"

This would appear to mirror according to your faith let it be done unto you ...

In Jeremiah 31:30a it says that every one shall die for his own iniquity.

Further in Job 15:33 "He shall shake off his unripe grape as the vine and shall cast forth his flower as the olive" The warning is clear and reflects the word in the New Testament "That when lust has conceived it bringeth forth sin, and sin when it is finished, bringeth forth death"

"Do not err my beloved brethren" (James 1:15,16)

In the book of Job, Eliphaz, heaped up words against Job (according to Job) But Job answered... I also could speak as you do: if your soul was in my souls stead, I could heap up words against you... and shake mine head as you.

But I would strengthen you with my mouth and the moving of my lips should assuage.

Assuage there in Job 16, literally is " to put an end to" or "put a stop to" it means "stifle" and "lenity"

Lenity is kindness and gentleness in other words to care.

The word of God says to speak the truth in love, this would reflect the lenity and the end, though the truth sets you free, in speaking the truth in love there is, or should be assuaging, there is little more to do than to pray.

Love produces good ground for the truth to be heard and be given insight, or understanding.

In ministry a person garners insights.

In that there is good ground, that the person believes you love. That there is a kingdom and a Lord.

That there is a Father that loves and sent his Son for you to have the life and inheritance of the new covenant.

To be born not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

In the Lord Jesus living in your heart. The Holy Spirit regenerates and sheds love abroad.

The word of God, In James, says "do not err". This has relation to:

eating the sour grape: The lust hath conceived, i.e. the sour grape conceives. And produces sin and sin death, you die for iniquity,

If you grieve the Holy Spirit, and even possibly quench the Holy Spirit. You may become a worker of iniquity, and it says the Lord does not know you.

All scripture is God breathed and good for reproof, correction and even doctrine.

In the old testament, Ezekiel says in chapter 18 that if the wicked turn (repent) from his sins which he hath committed, and keep the LORD'S statutes, and do that which is lawful (the law is spiritual) and right. He shall surely live.

In the new testament....

Ye must be born again, though even the Lord Jesus was loved by the Father as he kept his commandments and if you love the Lord you will keep his commandments.

In John 2 you see that the truth dwelleth in those born again and that we received the commandment from the Father to walk in truth.

As such God's goodness is toward us: If you continue in his goodness otherwise thou also shall be cut off. (Romans 11:22)

In Job, applying the verses, spiritually: "when deceived if you trust in vanity. You have vanity as a recompse. And when conceived mischief.

(lust when it conceives bringeth forth sin)

Conceive mischief (amal: iniquity: perverseness, worry, sorrows, grievance) and bring forth vanity and in your belly you prepare deceit.

You have grieved the Holy Spirit and quenched the Holy Spirit.

On the other hand when you are regenerate there are living waters flowing out of your belly And the fruit of the Spirit. You are a good tree, not a corrupt one.

As a regenerate christ-ian, to eat the sour grape...

(7)

... and grieve the Holy Spirit and eventually quench the Spirit, he builds those things which he repented for and which should have been destroyed.

Backsliding may be repent able for, Jesus is our advocate, but at what point it produces death.

"There is sin unto death and I do not say that he shall pray for it." (1 John 6:26)

I would believe you are nor longer in the kingdom. The seal of the Holy Spirit is the King's signet.

Presumptuous sin is hard to ask for advocacy, those who continue in presumptuous sin may be as Esau who sold his birth right and found no place of repentance though he sought it with tears.

And do not forget the cockles and thistles that may spring up!

"If you consent unto the law that it is good" If you say it is good then you have what the law says, cockles and thistles coming and may overtaking (Romans 7:16)

There is a deceiving of sin and a slewing, as sin takes occasion, by the commandment. (Romans 7:11)

In, I Corinthians 13:5 when taking communion we are to examine (G3985) ourselves whether ye be in the faith...

...prove yourselves, know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates (G86: adokinos: unapproved, rejected, worthless)

In the Septuagint "adokios" appears in Proverbs 25:4 as the word "dross'. in taking away the dross there shall come forth a vessel for the finer (to fuse metal)



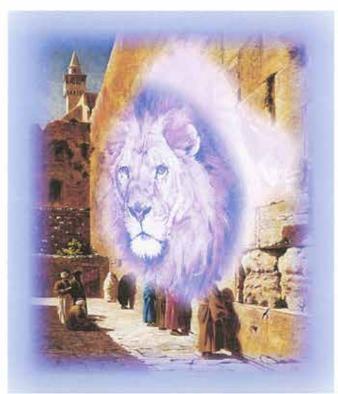
So how do you prove yourselves? <u>know ye not your own selves?</u>

Prove in the Greek is: dokimazo which is to test metals by fire and approve, to discern, examine, try.

To discern and examine as in I Corinthians II: to discern the Lord's body, and to examine yourselves, if we judge ourself we should not be judged

Those not discerning the Lord's body, who partake of the covenant unworthily, may be a sickly or sleep candidate.

Examining yourself, is in the light of doing charity, and unto the Lord, and not unto men. not frustrating grace we stand in.



The Lion hath roared, who will not fear? The LORD God spoke, who can but prophecy

As a Christian, In examining yourself, Jesus is your Lord and saviour, you have the word of truth and love present. We are to walk as he walked, and to walk in the light as he is in the light.

The LORD commanded for tehillah to go forth on the earth, The Lord sent the anointing and measure (psalm 147:15) he sends forth his commandment upon earth, his word runneth very swiftly.

tehillah is praise, giving him the glory, singing honor to his name, speaking of his great and wonderful works, his love to us in sending his Son, being rightwise with the King-dom,

But how does a man or woman ask him or her self? What frame of reference do they have? Albeit the word says that the eternal power and Godhead are seen. That which may be known of God is manifest, for God hath showed it unto them. (Romans 1:19,20)

Even morso a person in the world may hear many voices psychology, philosophy, vanity and even the spiritual darkness, the sway of the wicked one.

The word asks how shall they hear without a preacher. (Romans 10:13-15) preacher: kerusso: to herald (as a public crier): to proclaim, to publish abroad, announce to public.

To announce Jesus as the Messiah, being interpreted as The Christ, and the gospel as divine truth.

Hearing comes by the word of God.

Evil communications corrupt good manners (1 Corinthians 15:33) here the Greek word phteiro means: shrivel, waste, spoil, ruin, subvert.

Jesus asks the disciples: what manner of communications are these, that ye walk, and are sad.

The conversation of the old man is corrupt. We are to be renewed in the spirir of our mind.

Let no corrupt communication Proceed...

But that which is good, to the use of edifying (H3619 oikadome: architecture, confirmation)

To give an example of the dimensions, or effects in a life

"If you hate your brother you are in darkness, and walketh in darkness and knoweth not wither he goeth because that darkness has blinded his eyes" (1 John 2:11)

Now the Lord Jesus says that "thine eye be single thy whole body shall be full of light"

"But if thine eye evil, the whole body shall be full of darkness, if therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness"

(Matthew 6:22-23)

(16)

The darkness and blindness can manifest in "eating the sour grape" and your "teeth being set on edge". Some form or fashion of the sour grape is manifesting, and as in James when it conceives it is sin. And when it sets in it can carry with it "that thou know not where you goeth"

Such things as hating your brother, working ill to your neighbor, bidding someone God speed not in the doctrine of Christ.

"whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God...

You transgress when you have respect of persons.

(17)

There can be roots of bitterness that poison you, and spring up and poison many. So we are responsible to walk in the light as he is in the light.

Some sin may be so serious that there is no return, as selling your birthright for a morsel of food.

The works of the flesh in Galatians 5:19-21 "That they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God"

which do: prasso: means to practice, and implies repeated action, but may be of a single action.

The reason for going through the list is to garner spiritual dimensions.

- fornication: porneia: porneuo:
 To act the harlot, practice
 idolatry, from pornos: a
 debauchee
- 2) uncleanness: akarhousia: impurity, pollution
- 3) lascivousness: aselgesia:(not) continent, (in)temperanceDebauchery and perversion in general
- 4) idolatry: image-worship, from: eiddon: idol & latreia: service

Sorcerers may own drug companies and even though the drugs may be acceptable to God. The funds going to such groups may be so unacceptable, and snare you spiritually.

- 6) hatreds: ecthra: hostility, it is the feminine of ecthros, an adversary, foe, and be odious 7) variance: eris: wrangling, a quarrel, contention, debate, strife.
- 8) emulations; zelos (heat) in an unfavorable context, jealousy, envy (-ing) malice:- fervent mind, indignation, envy

As in James when lust hath conceived it <u>bringeth forth</u> sin, bringeth forth: to produce (from seed) sin when it is finished bringeth forth death.

<u>bringeth forth:</u> apokeo & tikto

apokueo: to breed forth, to generate, produce

<u>tikto:</u> to produce as from seed, as a mother or a plant

it metaphorically is irregular desire as exciting to sin.

it would seem a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump would be understandable in the context of these past pages.

In the Old Testament "when thou eateth the sour grape, thy teeth shall be set on edge"

Everyone shall die for his own iniquity i.e trusting in the sour grape, perverting deliberately, concious wrong doing, transgression in a concious sense.

from avah: bow down...
(22)

to crook, do amiss, make crooked, pervert,

"let your communication be Yea, yea, Nay, nay for what answer is more than that cometh of evil" (Matthew 5:37)

So in the context of eating the sour grape, how does Yea, yea, Nay, nay, play into conceiving of the sour grape?

The word of God says "Be ye not unequally yoked together (G2086: heterozugeo: to yoke up differently: to associate discordantly) with unbelievers.

For what fellowship (metoche :intercourse: participation)

hath righteousness with unrighteousness (G458: anomia: violation of law)

and what communion (G2842: kononia: participation: benefaction) hath light with darkness (shadiness)

and what concord (supnesis: accordance, from:G4866 sumphones: be suitable, concur or stipulate in harmonious accord, from G4859 sumpho: sounding together, from G4862 & 5456 sun: union with or together by association, companion, resemblance, possession, instrumentality, and Greek 5456, phone, disclosing a tone, saying or language, noise, sound, voice)

hath Christ with Belial or what part hath <u>he that</u> believeth with an infidel (apistos disbelieving, untrustworthy.

(24)

and what agreement hath the temple of God with (meta: amid, local or casual, transfer or sequence.

Idols

For ye are the temple of the living God, have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness but rather reprove (G1651: elegho: confute, admonish, put to shame, disgrace, to convict, prove to be wrong, to convince of error, refute, to detect, demonstrate, make manifest)

It would seem to be questionable to invest in companies that may themselves not question their sources as to spiritual integrity. to support, even indirectly, the work of the occult, or sorcerers, may be a snare.

(25)

In returning to examining ourselves. In the Old Testament the word says "those that seeth all his fathers sins" this can also encompass to those who seeth sins in his life (ra ah H7200:-advise self, consider, look, discern, perceive, mark, meet, take heed)

and considereth (H₇₂₀₀) and doeth not such like. and turn from them.

In the church, before the church, became Catholic and Evangelical (I am not a protestor i.e. protestant, there is only one church. "Jesus a Son over his house whose house we are" either you have the Spirit of Christ or nyou are none of his. Jesus is the head of the body which is the church)

The church had the Jurist and the interogatorium. In the interogatorium you are there asking yourself in light of the word and the Spirit, to examine anywhere you need to pray and repent,

In Job 33 " if you repent and say you have perverted that which is right. he will bring back your soul from the pit and enlighten it with the light of the living"

Repent, to turn from them, turn: shub:to change, reestablish restore, even to take vengeance on such sins.

In the New Testament it says, repent ye therefore and be converted (G1994) that your sins may be blotted out....

(27)

when times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord. (G1994: epistrepho: form epi: to and strepho: to turn)

In the New Testament such confessing our sins, means to turn, and Jesus being just and faithful, cleanses us from all unrighteousness.

blotting out: a cleansing from all unrighteousness.

<u>refreshing:</u> a recovery of breath: from anapsucho: to breath, to revive, to recreate.

We are labourers together with God, ye are God's husbandry, ye are a habitation for God.

Ye are God's (husbandry: georgion: cultivable)

As in the parable of the talents: he that received the talents (5 talents) went and traded (ergozomai) with what he was given.

Ergozomai in its Old Testament roots means to cultivate the earth with the works of God.

In James it talks about him that wavereth, let not that man think he shall receive anything of the Lord.

He that wavereth is driven by the wind, and it goes on to a double minded man. This can be the fruit of eating the sour grape, you really cannot even necessarily understand, because there can be blindness.

Every one that striveth G75 for the mastery. (G75 agonizomai: to contend with an adversary, or in the genitive to endeavor or accomplish)

...I therefore run the race, not as uncertainly (indistinct)

So fight I, not as one that beateth the air, but I keep under my body and bring it into subjection.

This is for an incorruptible crown (1 Corinthians 9: 25-27)

(G862: incorruptible: aphthartes the future body of saints: enduring, imperishable 1 Corinthians 15:52)

lest by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway G96

Those that wavereth (G6 dia: separation and krino, to judge, decide, to distinguish)

to separate oneself from judgment, distinguishing, deciding. is like the wave of the sea driven with the wind tossed to and fro.

castaway (G96) is from (a) without and dokimos: adokimos without dokimos: tried, proved, approved and therefore genuine, in metals after assayal.

The word goes on to say that friendship (philia) with the world is enmity with God.

enmity (G2189: hostility and opposition: from G2190: echthos: adversary, odious)

To give an example of odious, I used to smoke cigarettes, and a brother said I smell like tobacco not like Christ, I had the odious smell of cigarettes.

So in the Spirit man I was born again and had the savor of Christ, but in being a friend to the world, I was literally odious

It would seem that one of the things the earth is disquieted is an odious woman when she is married (Proverbs 30:21-23)

The word odious here is not saine, it does not bless or protect and also describes the person who hates wisdom: such a person loves death. (Proverbs 8:36)

If I have made gold my hope (H3689: kesel: from H3688 kasal: fat, silly, those taught by idols: H3684 kasiyl: fat stupid or silly: H3687 kesiluth): Proverbs 9:13: "a kesilut woman is clamorous, simple and knoweth nothing"

There are women (also men) that sitteth at the door of her house on a "kisseh" in the high places of the city.

To call (H₇₁₂₁) passengers (H₅6₇₄ & H₁6₇₀) to go right (H₃4₇₄) on their ways (H₇3₄) whoso is simple (H₆6₁₂) let him turn in thither, and as for him that wanteth understanding, she saith to him:

Stolen waters are sweet (H4985) and bread eaten in secret (secresies) is pleasant.

but he knoweth not that the dead are there: and that her guests (H₇₁₂₁) are in the depths of hell (H₇₅₈₅)

<u>To Call:</u> qara: means to call, but conveys, to summon, invite, invoke. <u>Passengers:</u> to cross over, transition, to make to cross over, pass through.

Those who go right: yashar: as Samson found a philistine woman pleasing (yashar) to him.

<u>Go right</u> " to be pleasing, one of the meanings which may cause you to be "simple" (H6612)

pethiy: silly i.e. seducible, it comes from pethah you are silly i.e. sillied in some form or fashion and can be allured, enticed, flattered and persuaded.

him that wanteth (H2638)
cheser lacking: destitute, need,
want-void, to lack.

understanding: leb: "the heart" the seat of one's inner nature or one of it's components...

(34)

.... or a specific aspect of personality. that it would seem to be lacking.

They hear that stolen waters are sweet (mathaq: be (made, take) sweet), bread eaten in secresies (privily, a cover) are pleasant (na em) agreeable, a delight, be sweet.

Leviticus 19:31 regard them not that have a familiar spirit, neither seek wizards to be defiled by them. vs. 20:6; and the soul that turneth after such as have familiar spirits (H178) and after wizards to go a whoring after them, I will set my face against that soul, and will cut him off from among the people.

.... or a specific aspect of personality. that it would seem to be lacking.

They hear that stolen waters are sweet (mathaq: be (made, take) sweet), bread eaten in secresies (privily, a cover) are pleasant (na em) agreeable, a delight, be sweet.

Leviticus 19:31 regard them not that have a familiar spirit, neither seek wizards to be defiled by them. vs. 20:6; and the soul that turneth after such as have familiar spirits (H178) and after wizards to go a whoring after them, I will set my face against that soul, and will cut him off from among the people.

In Deuteronomy 18: 10,11 there shall not be found among you.. he that useth divination (H781) an observer of times, or an enchanter or witch... or a charmer (H2267) or a consulter (H7592) with familiar with familiar spirits, or a wizard (H3049) or a necromancer.

2 Kings 23:24 Josiah put away the workers with fmiliar spirits, and the wizards, and the images (H8655) and idols (H1544)

As in Timothy there are those giving heed to seducing spirits and doctrines of devils (1 Timothy 4:1)

<u>seducing:</u> planos: imposter, misleading, deceiving.

There are those vexed (G₃₇₉₁) with unclean spirits (Luke 6:18)

Vexed: ochleo: a mob, harassed Unclean: akathartes: impure, morally lewd, foul, demonic...

Besides being "vexed" the enemy apparently can speak to you, we understand, that spirits talk, as the spirit of divination in the damsel (Acts 16:16) the damsel brought gain to her masters by soothsaying and a spirit of divination was able to speak through her.

I would have to believe that the spirit of divination speaking through the damsel are as the spirits in proverbs, and those who are silly (sillied) in some form or fashion may hear. And they become passengers. They may cross over, transition in the mind. They may hear the call of wizards, diviners, soothsayers, charmers, enchanters, they hear and it seems pleasant, sweet.

In the Lord Jesus house whose house we are. There is an operation of the Holy Spirit i.e. discerning of spirits, and power over unclean spirits (Luke 6:18).

But the wiles (schemes) of the devil include doctrines of devils, seducing spirits and even a sway.

When you hear seducing spirits rooted in doctrines of devils. You may have trafficking, and putting forth in form of merchandising. It can fill you with (chamas) "wrong"

unethical behavior, being involved in unjust gain, you treat people badly, you do spiritual violence and your wisdom becomes corrupted.

The devil may say that you are doing what I would know. Like you put a Jack-o-lantern at your door on Halloween. A jack-o-lantern is also called a will-o-wisp or an ignuus fatus, false lights that lead astray, you really, even though ignorantly, are hallowing and you are not hallowing the name of God at your door.

A pumpkin, is a pumpkin, created by God, a jack-o-lantern is a jack-o-lantern and a false light or fire, an ignuus fatus.

(40)

It would seem that there are sins of ignorance in the word of God. But it would seem that iniquity that is, or becomes, presumptuous, conscience, separates you from God and that iniquity that carries a punishment from the judge and has consequence. One result is being sillied.

In Isaiah 59, the iniquity, described is "avown" and is very serious, in that it includes transgression and lying against God, conceiving and uttering falsehood from the heart.

In the Psalms "avown" that those who imagine it "mischief" against a man are slain, and as a bowing wall ye shall be...

(41)

... as a tottering fence i.e. silly, sillied, and that to whatever greater or lesser extent we commit such iniquity. judgment is turned away backward and the Fathers judgments which were helping may not be any longer. Justice standeth afar off, truth is fallen in the street. The Father upheld the prophet so that none of his words fell to the ground. Yes truth faileth.

In Luke 6:11 The Lord Jesus had spoken on the Sabbath that it is lawful to do good on the Sabbath. to save life not to destroy it, and Jesus, by the power of God, the man's withered hand was restored.

The Lord obviously spoke true, the man's withered hand was restored whole as the other. Right there in the synagogue on the Sabbath. God certainly does not hear heretic or blasphemer a performing a miracle according to Jesus spoken word.

Yet they were filled with madness (G₄₅₄) and communed with one another what they might do to Jesus.

They literally were filled with madness in the face of the truth. Perhaps imagining "avown" against Jesus made them mad.

Solomon gave way in his life to "outlandish" (H5237) women. Even though warned by God. Solomon became involved with other god's outlandish: nekar: heathendom

I believe that Solomon at the end, had recovered, he went forth on his palanquin (appiryown) the midst thereof being paved with love for the daughters of Yerushalim.

The bible warns about eating the sour grape. That there is a double minded who is unstable in his ways (dipsuchos) two & soul, two & spirited. Haps in opinion and in conflicting fruit or purpose. Such cannot receive from the Lord and judgment is far from you, justice cannot overtake you (you are tossed to and fro)

(44)

You wait for the light but behold obscurity for brightness (Isaiah 59:9)

In Job: Job says what then shall I do when God riseth up? And when he visiteth, what shall I answer him?

Job 31 to me are standards as in the new testament. That if ye are a respecter of persons ye become a transgressor of the law. When you stand in grace, you are living those standards spiritually and in frustrating that grace we may become transgressors of the law. In Job thistles and cockle grow. But of a course when standing in grace wheat and barley grow.

Thistles (boshah) are weeds, really stink weed. They have a stench and are noxious.

Cockles are things that pierce i.e. thorns, even a ring for the nose. Perhaps the worldly proverb "to be led around by the nose" may be a result of incorporating aspects of Job 31 into your life, or eating the sour grape.

In Song of Solomon the garden, which may be the Lord's garden in the kingdom sends forth an orchard of pomegranets, with pleasant fruits, camphire and spikenard, spikenard and saffron, calamus and cinnamon with all trees of frankincense and myrrh...

(46)

... and aloes with all the chief spices.

"Awake O north wind; and come thou south; blow upon my garden, that the spices thereof may flow out" (Song 4:16)

In Job:

"my heart hath been secretly enticed" (H6601) or my mouth hath kissed (H546) my hand (H3087)

pathah (H6601) pathah is translated into english as: allure, deceive, entice, flatter, persuade, enlarge, silly (one). It conveys "to be open" "be roomy"

And if your mouth hath kissed (surely, verily)my hand (power, means direction) in some way that it denies God above.

(47)

It is an iniquity to be punished by the judge (Job 31: 27,28)

Jesus may have read Job 31
"If I have seen (H7200) any
perish for want of clothing, or
any poor without covering"

to see: ra ah: to see by volition, to select as already said respecters of persons become transgressors of the law (James 2:9)

"For if ye love them which love you, what reward have ye? do not even the publicans do the same"

"Verily I say unto you, in as much as ye did it not unto one of the least of these ye did it not unto me"

Did not he that made me in the womb make him?

(48)

...and did not one fashion in the womb (Job 31:15)

"ye are committing sin and are convinced of the law as transgressors"

(convinced (G1651) elegcho: to confute, admonish, to shame, disgrace, to convict, to prove you are wrong)

(transgressors: parabatos: a violator; from G3845 parabaino: To go away, to move, to go aside from)

"You are not under law but under grace"

The fruit of the Spirit... <u>against</u> such there is no law (Gal. 5:23)

Standing in grace... against such there is no law.

In 2 John 6 we have received commandment from the Father to love one another:

(49)

and this is love: that we walk after his commandments.

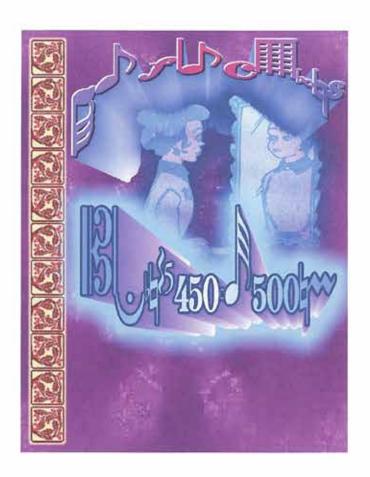

says:

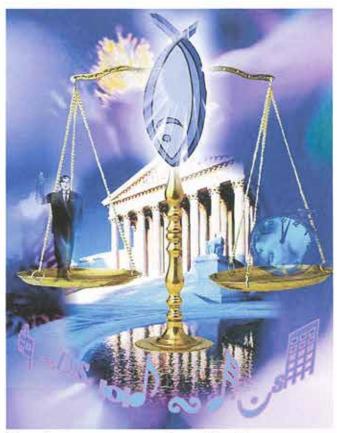

In Matthew you are living in grace, and you love, your love and standing in grace reaps its reward in loving kindness.

But at the same time truth is truth. Krima is krima, you cannot say krima is not krima, The decision for or against crime.

You need to plead for justice and haste righteousness, but mercy and truth has to go before your face, as it does his.

"He that withhold corn, the people shall curse (H5344: specify, designate, libel) but blessing shall be on the head of him that selleth it"

But you still need to pray grace and truth.

(54)

Perhaps quoting the verse to him would be grace and truth. Speaking the truth in love, and it would seem it is your responsibility to warn a person, of course in love.

For there is no power but of God!



The word says: He that troubeleth you shall bear his judgment.

troubeleth: tarasso: to stir or agitate: roil water.

In the New Testament
"I would that they were even
cut off which trouble (G367)
you" the word trouble is:
anastatoo: to drive out of home
but is translated in one occasion
as "to turn upside down"

The unfruitful works of darkness you are to reprove (G1651: elegcho) to confute, admonish, shame, disgrace, convict, prove wrong, convince of error, refute, rebuke, detect and demonstrate and make manifest.

All things reproved (G1651) are made manifest by the light.

Those who invoke evil against you, wish evil to you, we are to bless (eulogeo)

"to pray for one's welfare as God perceives it for his actions in their lives" (Spiros Zodhiates: Hebrew Greek key word study Bible)

Bless and curse (G2672: doom, excreate) not.

If you pray as Spiros says but you also say to the Father, in Jesus, that you libel, that you reprove, you can even say they appear to need to be turned upside down.

If the Father turns them upside down... The Father's will is what you are praying for as to welfare as God perceives it.

In the word those who preach any other gospel and pervert the gospel of Christ are cursed (G331) they are anathema

The greek anathema, in the Septuagint (the greek translation of the old testament) is there for the Hebraic word: "charam" (H2673) and means:

"to be blunt" you are in essence a contradictory element

The Hebraic in "teeth set on edge" is qahah and also means

"to be blunt" there is a contradictory element that may carry a curse from God, is an iniquity to be punished by the judge. In other words violations and judgment.

Eating the sour grape....

(58)

may be a contradictory element causing judgment on sin. Or as Deuteronomy 28 says: that it may come upon you and eventually overtake you. Unless Jesus the advocate forgives and cleanses of all unrighteousness.

Covenant violation is just as serious in the new as in the old. As alredy said many can be sickly and sleep who do not examine themselves and eat worthily.

Thou to believe that you can presumptuously eat the sour grape and survive, questionable sane.

Even King David, though forgiven had a sword over his house.

"all such who rejoice in their boasting, that all such rejoicing is evil" (poneros: in masculine (singular) the devil, or plural sinners)

(It is calamitous, ill, diseased, culpable i.e. derilict, malice facinerous, mischief)

"she that liveth in pleasure (H4684) is dead (H2348) while she liveth"

(live in pleasure, wanton,to be voluptuous, self gratification)

"my son if sinners (H2400) entice (H6609) thee consent (H14) not" (Proverbs 1:10)

(A mental assent that may agree in principle may be consenting)

Agreeing in principle, even by desire, may produce lust, inordinate affections.

Those that are un-right-ous Adios: without and justice, shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

As Paul says things may be lawful to you, but may not be expedient and that he would not be brought under the power of any (1 Corinthians 6:12)

Be not deceived, neither fornicators: pornos, nor idolators: eidololatres: image worship or servant of, nor adulterers: to lust may be in this word, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind: sodomite: assenkoites: From arrhen: male and koite couch, cohabitation male sperm,

nor theives: klepto: but may extend to false teachers or deceivers who steal men from the truth (John 10: 8,10) nor covetous: pleneskteo: avarice, a defrauder, nor drunkard: tipsy: madhouses: we are to walk as he walked: to emulate the character of Jesus: Jesus is the charakter of God: the express image.

As noted already in Job, let not him that is deceived trust in vanity, for vanity shall be his recompse (H8345)

(Recompse: temuwrah: change or exchange)

This principle manifest in the world.

In Romans I: 20-25 (64) "that they became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish hearts were darkened, they professed themselves to be wise, they became fools and changed... the glory of the uncorruptible God... into an image like unto corruptible man"

The Lord Jesus said:

"no man also soweth a piece of a new cloth upon an old garment, if otherwise the new piece that filled it up taketh away from the old and maketh a rent (G4878) worse"

sunantilanbanonai: take hold of opposites together :schizo cherion: more evil, worse

"The piece that was out of the new agreeth not with the old" (Luke 5:36; Matthew 9: 16; Mark 2:21)

agreeth: sumphoneo: accord, from sumphonos: accordant.

You are in dis-cord like the fountain sending forth both fresh water and salt water, sweet water and bitter, and you become schizo, and like the wine bottle of the next verse you break.

When a brother or sister is in these states, as in the barren fig tree (Luke 13:6-9) you can be before the Lord and dig around the tree and dung it. But in the next year if it has not born fruit it is cut down.

The end is he shall shake off his unripe (sour) grape as the vine and shall cast off his flower as the olive (Job 15:33)

"Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth to life,and few there be that find it" (Matthew 7:14)

In the end... when all this is in the midst of the land among the people, there shall be a shaking of an olive tree and as the gleaning grapes when the vintage is done (Isaiah 24:13-15)

In the end when the Lord maketh the earth and maketh it waste and turneth it upside down (H6440)

There shall be as the shaking of an olive tree, and as the gleaning grapes... ... when the vintage is done. You are to be abiding in the vine. The alternate is to be cast forth as a withered branch.

Do not let philosophy or fables spoil you...

Philosophia: Jewish sophistry or forms of sophistry: sophistry is the use of fallacious arguments, designed to deceive.

philosophus: fond of "wise" things.

philos: fond, friendly associate sophos: literally: cleverly wisely Theosophy: false statements appearing true or plausible.

In psychology there is the persuasive arguments theory.

"where is the wise?

where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this world?

...hath not God made foolish the wisdom of the world?"

Appearing in the world are working by the devil and his sway are witchcrafts, sorcerers, enchanters, magics, soothsayers.

The word says "thou shalt not suffer a witch to live"

Are you a disputer of these things?

\or do you invest in companies that are a party to them? Do you dispute Satan's Voices \or do you vote for people and parties that give these voices a voice?

Civil rights appears to have done good for minorities, and for rights in general. But it has now become:

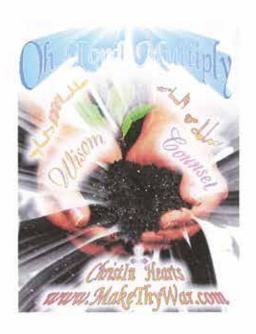
... a two-edged sword, giving voice, to many voices, founded in the father of lies.

There are those who stand against God such as Jammes and Jambres who withstood Moses. In the end they had to say that the wonders and deliverance was the finger of God. In the New Testament it says that as Jammes and Jambres, those who resist the truth, their folly will be made known.

These people, such as Jammes and Jambres, are present today and as Jammes and Jambres they may hold power and authority. They legislate mischief by a law and their voice is somehow made acceptable even for our children to hear. Children are a heritage of the Lord. The heritage even sees many of Christendom giving voice to these voices. It is as bad as smoking cigarettes in front of your children.

You allow these things to live that have no inheritance in the kingdom of God.

To suffer a witch to live means to allow works of the father of lies, to live, even possibly to the loss of your heritage in the Lord, your children. As Job asked what will you say to God when he visits? Will you say I am a democrat? And I support these agenda's. Not to mock people who somehow believe they are trying to be citizens. But I am a christian and citizen of the kingdom of God.



In regards to communication, The word says that foolish talking nor jesting are not convenient.

The Greek word for convenient is aneko (G6433) It means "to attain to" "to arrive" to "be present"

The giving of thanks causes you to be present

In Philemon:

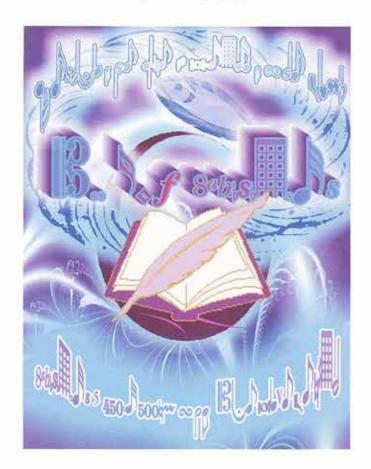
" wherefore I might be much bold in Christ to enjoin (G2004) thee that which is convenient.

Paul rather than enjoining that which is convenient, beseeches.

The word enjoin (epitasso) means to arrange upon, order, appoint, give an order.

The word "tasso" means to "put as duty" "ordain" "set" "ordain position" and there are those ordained, appointed to eternal life (Acts 13:48)



Do not rejoice that the spirit's are subject unto but rather your name is written in heaven

There is another word in the Greek that means "to appoint" G1303: diatithemai: the word conveys, in its meaning, that of a testator, of a testamentary disposition, to set out in order.

"and I appoint unto you a kingdom as my Father appointed unto me" (Luke 22:29)

In the word, Jesus is the testator, the Greek diatithemai also means to institute or make a covenant.

"and for this cause he is the mediator of the New Testament that by means of death for the redemption of the transgression That were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance" Hebrews 9:15

we understand that a testament is of force after a man has passed. That there must also of necessity be the death of the testator.

It may require a leap of faith to understand that "almost all things are by the law purged with blood" and without shedding of blood is no remission.

The first testament was dedicated by blood, Moses spoke every precept to all the people according to the law... (to understand liturgical fire takes faith that God instituted the old testament sacrifices. That when you offered the dove on the altar you prayed and the fire as the sacrifice was burned up cleansed your heart of sin)

He took the blood of calves and of goats with water and scarlet wool, and hyssop and sprinkled both the book and all the people.

"saying, this is the blood of the testament which God hath enjoined unto you"

Moreover he sprinkled with bllod both the tabernacle and all the vessels of the ministry. Jesus, death as testator, and his shed blood, (is the testament and the blood of sprinkling) perfected forever them that are sanctified.

The new testament was instituted as covenant with Jesus as the mediator.

"For this is the covenant that I will make (diatithemai) with the house of Israel after these days, saith the Lord: I will put my laws into their mind, and write them into their hearts: and I will be to them a God and they shall be to me a people" (Hebrews 8: 10-13)

Jesus is a Son over his house whose house we are.

" A minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle which the Lord pitched and not Man"

Jumping to Ezekiel 43 " thou son of man show (H5046) the house to the house to the house of Israel, that they may be ashamed of their iniquities and let them measure the pattern (H8508: tokniyth: admeasurement, consummation, sum)

And if they be ashamed of all they have done (H6213) shew (H3045) them the form (H6699) of the house and the fashion (H8498) thereof and the goings out thereof and the comings in thereof and all the forms (H6699) thereof...

and all the ordinances (H2708) Thereof and all the forms (H6699) and all the laws (H8451) thereof.

And write in their sight that they may keep the whole form (H6699) thereof and all the ordinances (H2708) thereof and do them.

This is the law (H8451) of the house; upon the top of the mountain the whole limit thereof round about shall be most holy (H6944)

Behold, this is the law of the house.

The form H6699: tsuwrah: form, Rock..

The ordinances H2708 chuqqah:

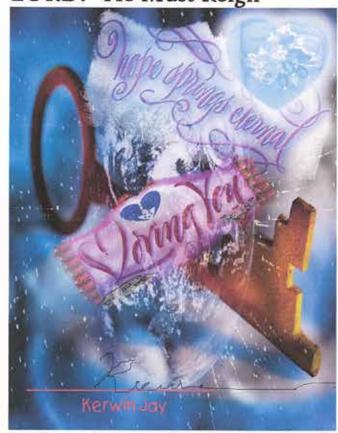
