"Moreover Hezekiah the King and the princes
Commanded the Levites to sing praise ^{H1984} unto the LORD
with the words of David, and of Asaph the seer. And
they sang praises with gladness, and they bowed their
heads and worshipped"

* note (H1984 halal: halal v jah)

"Blessed be the LORD God of Israel, forever and ever,
and all the people said, Amen, and praised ("halal")

I will greatly praise (yadah) the LORD with my mouth;
yeah, I will praise (halal) him among the multitude.

For he shall stand at the right hand of the poor,
to save him from those that condemn ^{H8199} (the Judges

For in the days of David and Asaph of old there were chief of the Singers and songs of praise and thanksgiving unto God (^{tehillah} Nehemiah 12:46)

And these are the Singers, chief of the fathers of the Levites, who remaining in the chambers were free: for they were employed in that work day and night (1 Chronicles 9:33)

And they began to sing and to praise the Lord set ambuscades against the children of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten. (2 Chronicles 20:22)

If there be any famine, if there be pestilence, blasting, mildew, locust, or if there be caterpillar; if their enemy besiege them in the land of their cities; whatsoever plague, whatsoever sickness there be;
