# **Upcoming Events and Changes**

- Canada Post National Strike due to the ongoing Canada Post labour dispute, invoice, letters, and notices may be delayed. During the dispute, invoices will be sent out via email, or residents may pick up a copy at the Village Office. Please ensure your mailing address and email address are current with the Village Office.
- Next Water & Sewer Billing Cycle (Mid October) residents will notice a \$15 quartely fee added to their water and sewer bill. This is a recycling levy that was originally scheduled to take effect on Dec. 16, 2021. ## **Upcoming Council Meetings 2025**

Council meetings start at 7:00pm and are always open to the public. Please feel free to sit in and observe. If you would like to be added to the meeting agenda, please send an email.

- **Property Taxes** assessment and property taxes for 2025 were mailed out in early September. The deadline to pay taxes is December 31, 2025 in order to avoid a monthly late penalty fee of 1.5% starting January 2026. Payments may be made by cash or cheque at the Village Office, or by using Option Pay or E-transfer. If you choose to pay via E-transfer, please be sure to include which account (e.g., utilities or taxes) your payment is for in the message section, so we can apply it correctly.
- **Garbage collection** starts at 9:00am on Thursdays. Garbage must be properly bagged and, on the curb, or it will not be collected. Please note that the following items are not accepted: furniture, appliances, electronics, building and reno materials, bulk items, oil, fuel, paint, chemicals, and batteries.
  - **Reminder:** Please do not leave garbage or unwanted materials at the Town Shop.
- **Recycling** The recycling bin is emptied once a month. Please remember to flatten all cardboard boxes before placing them in the bin.
- **Yard waste** including plant material, grass clippings, leaves, weeds, and branches can be placed in the designated pile next to Pepper's Park (ball diamond).
