Upcoming Events and Changes

- **Spring Clean Up** – we will be holding a community spring clean up day. May 30, 2026 from 10am – 12pm. Meet at community centre and grab some garbage bags and sign up as a BBQ lunch will be provided for the volunteers.
- **The Village of Killaly** – is now signed up for Fine Options. You can now work off your Fine in our village in lieu of payment.
- **Village Orchard** – The village has decided to open up the property to the left of the office to begin a small orchard. People can purchase their own tree to be planted in their name. We will donate a bench for you to decorate as you wish. **Make sure to contact office if you wish to have a tree planted.** This way we can know where you want tree planted and when so we can have hole dug and plant tree when ready.
- **Pepper's Park** – will be open as soon as the ground is dry enough for us to maintain it

Reminders

- **Property tax notices** have been sent out. Our Administrator will be in the office to collect payments. You can also make payment by using Option Pay or by E-transfer to: villageofkillaly@gmail.com.

- **Water bills** for Jan – March have been issued. You can make payments by using Option Pay or E-transfer. If you choose to pay via E-transfer, please be sure to include which account (e.g., utilities or taxes) your payment is for in the message section, so we can apply it correctly.
- **Garbage collection** starts at 9:00am on Thursdays. Garbage must be properly bagged and, on the curb, or it will not be collected. Please double bag heavy and sloppy bags. Please note that the following items are not accepted: furniture, appliances, electronics, building and reno materials, bulk items, oil, fuel, paint, chemicals, and batteries.
- **Garbage Bin** – Please do not leave garbage bags on top of our garbage bin. If you miss garbage pick up you will have to wait until the next week.
- **Yard waste** including plant material, grass clippings, leaves, weeds, and branches can be placed in the designated pile next to Pepper's Park (ball diamond). No construction waste, this must go to city dump.
- **Recycle Bin** – The Blue recycle bin is for **cardboard and paper ONLY**. Please do not place household plastics and tin into the bin. ALSO please **breakdown** cardboard before placing in the bin so it does not fill so fast.
- **SPEEDING**- please watch your speed on Railway avenue, we have lots of small children that live and play on that street.
- **Litering** – please stop throwing garbage out your car windows. This is a reminder we have cameras on railway ave. and can see you. If this continues, it will be considered littering and fines will be given.
