Reminders

- **It is Tax Season!** Property tax notices have been sent out. Our Administrator will be in the office to collect payments. You can also make payment by using Option Pay or by E-transfer to: villageofkillaly@gmail.com.
- **Water bills** for July - September have been issued. You can make payments by using Option Pay or E-transfer. If you choose to pay via E-transfer, please be sure to include which account (e.g., utilities or taxes) your payment is for in the message section, so we can apply it correctly.

- **Garbage collection** starts at 9:00am on Thursdays. Garbage must be properly bagged and, on the curb, or it will not be collected. Please note that the following items are not accepted: furniture, appliances, electronics, building and reno materials, bulk items, oil, fuel, paint, chemicals, and batteries.
- **Yard waste** including plant material, grass clippings, leaves, weeds, and branches can be placed in the designated pile next to Pepper’s Park (ball diamond).
