January Facts

New Year's Day - The most celebrated holiday around the world.

January 1, 1892 - Ellis Island in New York Harbor opened. Over 20 million arrivals to America were processed until it closed in 1954.



January 3, 1959 - Alaska was admitted as the 49th U.S. state with a land mass almost one-fifth the size of the lower 48 states together.

January 4, 1790 - President George Washington delivered the first State of the Union address.

January 6, 1941 - President Franklin Roosevelt delivered his State of the Union address to Congress asking for support for the lend-lease program aiding Allies fighting the Axis powers and defined 4 essential freedoms worth defending; freedom of speech, freedom of worship, freedom from want, and freedom from fear.

January 8, 1982 - The American Telephone and Telegraph (AT&T) Company was broken up as a result of an antitrust suit. AT&T gave up 22 local Bell system companies, opening the U.S. telephone system to competition.

January 20, 1945 - Franklin Delano Roosevelt was inaugurated to an unprecedented fourth term as president of the United States. He had served since 1933.

January 20, 1981 - Ronald Reagan became president of the United States at the age of 69, the oldest president to take office.

January 21, 1976 - The Concorde supersonic jet began passenger service with flights cruising at twice the speed of sound (Mach 2) at an altitude up to 60,000 feet.

January 25, 1961 - President John F. Kennedy conducted the first live televised presidential news conference.



January Birthday Trivia (answers on page 11)

January 8, 1935 was born in Tupelo, MS. Regarded as one of the most significant cultural icons of the 20th century, referred to as the "King of Rock and Roll" or simply "the King".
January 9, 1913 the 37th U.S. President, was born in Yorba Linda, CA. He served as vice president under Eisenhower, then made an unsuccessful run for the presidency.
January 15, 1929 was born in Atlanta, GA. As an African American civil rights leader he spoke eloquently and stressed nonviolent methods to achieve equality.
January 17, 1706 was born in Boston, MA. Considered the Elder Statesman of the American Revolution, he displayed multiple talents as a printer, author, publisher, philosopher, scientist, diplomat and philanthropist.
January 17, 1942 was born in Louisville, KY. At 22 in 1964, he knocked out Sonny Liston to win the world heavyweight boxing championship, shouting out "I shook up the world!"
January 19, 1809 poet and writer of mystery and suspense tales, was born in Boston, MA. His works include; <i>The Fall of the House of Usher, Tales of the Grotesque and Arabesque, The Murders in the Rue Morgue</i> and his famous poem <i>The Raven</i> .
January 27, 1832 - British novelist was born in Cheshire, England. Best known for <i>Alice's Adventures in Wonderland</i> and <i>Through the Looking Glass.</i>
January 30, 1882 the 32nd U.S. President was born in Hyde Park, NY. Despite crippling polio, he led America out of the Great Depression and through World War II and is widely considered to be one of America's three greatest presidents.
January 31, 1919 was born in Cairo, GA. He was the first African American to play professional baseball. He played for the Brooklyn Dodgers from 1947 to 1956, was chosen as the National League's most valuable player in 1949 and elected to the Baseball Hal of Fame in 1962.
