I

The name of this corporation is Senior Center of Elk
Grove.

II

This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation
for the private gain of any person. It is organized
and is not organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation
Law for public and charitable purposes. The public purposes for
which the corporation is organized include the construction for opera-
tion of a senior citizen's activity center in Elk Grove.

III

The name and address of the corporation's initial agent
for service of process is Richard Lichtenberger, 9713 Elmtree Way,
Elk Grove, California, 95624. If the person designated as agent
for service of process resigns, is not reelected or dies another
person shall be named as agent. A statement setting forth the new
agent's name and address shall be filed promptly with the Secretary
of State's Office.

IV

A. The property of this corporation is irrevocably
dedicated to charitable purposes, and no part of the net income or
assets of this organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any
director, officer, or member of this corporation, or to the benefit
of any private individual.

B. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation,
and after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations
of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a


nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation that is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and that has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

V


A. This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall this corporation participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for political office.


