

Angel Island is a wonderful natural resource, rich in California history. Take the short ferry ride from Tiburon and journey into the island's historical and cultural past. During the Civil War, the island was fortified to defend San Francisco Bay from confederate forces. In the 19th century, new arrivals to the U.S. entering the San Francisco were housed and processed in quarters located at the Pacific Mail Steamship Company docks on the waterfront. After the quarters proved inadequate and unsanitary, a study, authorized in 1904, recommended building a new immigration station on the isolated and nearby Angel Island, now known as the Ellis Island of the West.
