Scam Prevention

There seems to be a new scam to watch for every day. How can you tell what is a scam and what is legitimate?

Please treat all <u>unsolicited</u> calls as a potential scam. It's ok to not answer, it's ok to hang up, it's ok to be rude, IT'S OK TO SAY NO.

It's an unfortunate fact that our personal information is out there and readily available for the "bad guys" to purchase. Your full name, address, phone number, social security number, family member names, even neighbors names and information. Scammers will use it ALL to convince you they are the IRS, Social Security, Medicare, law enforcement, family members or others. To reassure our members, the Senior Center NEVER sells or gives away any information about our current or prior members.

The IRS will **NEVER CALL YOU** without a prior letter confirming a call.

The SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION will **NEVER ASK YOU** for your social security number to "verify" it. They issued it.

LAW ENFORCEMENT will **NEVER TELL YOU** THEY'RE COMING AFTER YOU. They'll just show up if you're a wanted person. No warning calls.

Your GRANDCHILD is probably **not** in ARGENTINA for a wedding, had their luggage stolen and need money to get home.

MEDICARE already knows your card number. They WON'T ASK FOR IT, they issued it, nor are they sending out DNA kits.

Scam Prevention

Getting you to give them information is what they're good at. If you are uncomfortable IN ANY WAY, hang up. For example, one senior received a phone call: "Grandma? It's your grandson. I'm in Portugal and lost my tickets. Could you send me money to get home?" Grandma said "Brian?" Luckily, she figured out it was a scam and hung up, but not before she gave them information (her grandson's name) she shouldn't have.

If you're feeling unsure of the information the caller is requesting, ask for their name, their company name, phone number and address. Then you can hang up and do a little research. Please feel free to call the Senior Center, call the police department, or call someone who may help give you a little clarity. **IF YOU** decide to call this person back, look up the company phone number on the internet, or ask someone with computer skills to look the company up. Call THAT number, NOT the one the caller gave you.

If the caller asks you to send money, **HANG UP**. If they request "cash" mailed to them, debit cards, gift cards or any other way that seems even the slightest bit odd, HANG UP. **Once your money is gone, it's gone.**

The FBI, Federal Trade Commission (FTC), AARP, Better Business Bureau (BBB), Department of Justice (DOJ) and other organizations have information about the latest scams that are finding their way to or directly aimed at seniors.

Remember - it is ALWAYS ok to say NO, it's ALWAYS ok to HANG UP, it's ALWAYS ok to say NOT INTERESTED, it's ALWAYS ok to say I WILL RESEARCH THIS FIRST if they're pressuring you about time. It's ALWAYS OK TO BE CAUTIOUS.

Scam Prevention

Often, they're seeking information they can use to open credit card and loan accounts in your name. The Fair Credit Reporting Act requires each of the major credit reporting agencies provide you with a free credit report once every 12 months. The website is www.AnnualCreditReport.com is recommended by the FTC. It's very important to check your credit report often to make certain there is no fraudulent credit opened in your name.

Many data breaches are happening as well. Data breaches are when a company has their sensitive information stolen electronically. If you have concerns call or go to the web site of the company whose data was breached and follow their instructions about how to protect your information. Many offer free credit monitoring if they're breached. Please remember, do not give out your information over the phone! Go directly to the company for answers.

Got a one-ring hang up call? DON'T CALL BACK, it could be an international toll number that will charge your phone account heavily. Don't trust Caller ID. It's very easy to fake a phone number or name. If you don't recognize the number - even if it says IRS - let it go to voicemail. Got a call from an unknown number - even one from your area code or city? Let it go to voicemail. You can hear who it is in a few minutes when you listen to the voicemail and decide if it's anyone you wish to speak with.

There are countless ways scammers are trying to take your money. We simply cannot list them all. The Senior Center often contacts various agencies for their scam updates: there are steps you can take if you have been the victim of a scam. We want to help point you in the right direction. Our members are always our main priority.
